Mary got up before dawn, gathered her spices, and headed to the tomb. (John 20) She didn't have high expectations. I'm not sure how she planned to have the stone moved so she could do her embalming work. I'm not saying she had a lot of faith, but she had a lot of faithfulness. When resurrection happened she was there.



We can't make resurrections happen, but we can be there. We can be faithful. We can be present. We can open the windows and doors of our souls and invite the Spirit to blow through, and we can be present when it happens.

I don't know what areas of your life need to be resurrected, and I can't guarantee that, even with the beginning of spring, there will be new buds of promise. There are three plants on our patio. We water all three of them regularly. One already has budded out and is green and growing wildly. The other two still look dead, and we don't know if they will grow again. I do know, though, that they won't if we don't water them, so we do what we can and we leave the results to the life that is in them.

The season of Easter is the time when we get to nurture our soul like watering a plant. It is the time when we stick to our faithfulness in spite of all that is going on in the world around us. It is the time during which we pray for the Holy Spirit to break into our lives like a fiery whirlwind and as tender as a

bud on a plant. If they grow – plants and souls alike - we will have "flowers" in the summer, if they do not we will enjoy what already is growing like we never doubted it.

Curiosity is an emotion followed by behavior. Curiosity is based on the undesirable experiences of "uncertainty". The reduction of these unpleasant feelings, in turn, is rewarding. In general humans desire coherence and understanding in their thought processes. When this coherence is disrupted by something that is unfamiliar, uncertain, or ambiguous, it is curiosity that attempts to gather information and knowledge of the unfamiliar to restore coherence once again.

In Scripture Thomas might be a timely example: After Jesus' resurrection the other disciples had seen the risen Christ. Thomas, not present at that event, remains uncertain if this is possible and indeed his beloved teacher. He wants clarity by examining Jesus' wounds. Only after Thomas had curiously poked his finger into Jesus' side, he believes that it is he and Jesus is alive.

After quite some time here at Gethsemane Lutheran Church I wonder what it is that currently you might find unsettling here? What would you like to understand about Gethsemane? Are you curious at all? And if you are, what are you doing about it?

Thomas and the disciples are talking among each other. I think this is a clue for us, too: The word *curiosity* relates to the Latin word *cura*, which means "care". In other words someone who is curious cares enough to take action. And as the story of Thomas and the disciples reads, one way is to talk to others. Therefore I invite and encourage you to be in ongoing conversation about what matters to you here at Gethsemane. I am sure it matters to God as well! PK

upbeat and full-of-hope experience!


