Our series of articles continue with our core ministries:

(2) Food Pantry When the housing bubble collapsed and California was hit with a recession in 2010, Pastor Gloria, Brenda Casey and Carl Demas (this is how GLC, MMACC and the Serra Mesa Community Council demonstrated their collaboration!) stuck their heads together on how to support and help the larger community. A grant from Ron Roberts (District 4 representative on the San Diego County Board of Supervisors in CA) secured funds for a refrigerator and a computer. The rest is history; and ever since the Food Pantry is serving a number of folks in need within our zip code.

If you take the time to visit with the pantry's leader, Luisa Johnson and her volunteers (see picture) on any given Wednesday between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. you will be amazed at their dedication and joy. There is happiness in that place! They know their clients, deeply care and do everything with love. Together with the volunteer drivers who gather rescued food from restaurants and companies/organizations like Jewish Family Service, Hill Crest bakery Bread and Cie and others as well as fresh produce from our Community Garden, it is a true team effort!

The pantry serves 80 to 100 customers per week; at Thanksgiving and Christmas the numbers climb to 120. They are accountable to the San Diego Foodbank Commodities and Feed San Diego Commodities. It files accurate reports on the activity, and lives up to the official standards required. What a meaningful ministry! PK

(3) GLC's Social Ministries With a Walking Twist

Social ministries at Gethsemane come in very diverse forms and activities, two of which are being highlighted this month as part of an occasional series to familiarize (or re-familiarize) our Witness readers with Gethsemane's impactful and important work in the larger world.

This month's featured ministries both involve "pounding the pavement" (in a positive way): the Pride Parade and the NAMI Walk.

The annual San Diego **Pride Parade** is among the largest in the United States, attracting over 100,000 cheering spectators.

GLC's participation in the Pride Parade started a few years ago when we accepted First Lutheran's invitation to walk with them and others in the San Diego Lutheran community (this was the 25th Anniversary of First Lutheran's becoming a Reconciling in Christ congregation).

More recently, GLC members and friends have joined MMACC in a collaborative marching effort which visibly demonstrates our commitment as a Lutheran Christian congregation welcoming to all.

Our marchers carry "Gethsemane" signs to communicate our welcoming presence to the LGBT community, which has resulted in many warm hugs and thank you's along the parade route.

Another annual event, the **NAMI Walk**, is a fundraiser for the National Alliance on Mental IIIness. Past member Helen Bergen (now living in Minnesota) was very involved in the local NAMI chapter, and GLC has embraced supporting NAMI's efforts to destigmatize mental illness.

GLC fields a team of walkers (the "Gethsemane Gardeners") to raise funds for the NAMI Walk through pledges. The walkers sport their team T-shirts to show GLC's support for NAMI's mission and to gain exposure in the community.

When GLC has offered Candlelighting for Mental Illness during worship service, nearly everyone came forward and lit a candle to show their support and solidarity with family members and/or friends who live with mental illness. GLC has also supported NAMI by inviting them to use the Garden Room for their programs.
