#### **News From The Call Committee**

The Call Committee met as planned on May 6<sup>th</sup> and reached consensus on the initial candidates provided by the Synod. Certain candidates were invited to continue in conversation, and later in May each of these candidates met separately with the committee.

During these conversations, the Call Committee has been guided by Gethsemane's Mission Site Profile (MSP), which incorporated the congregation's input to the Transition Team gained from various surveys and discussion forums.

The Call Committee has particularly relied upon the Transition Team's presentation of Gethsemane's "Top 5" areas for the new pastor's priorities (these are not in any order of importance):

- 1. LEADERSHIP Be able to develop relationships to work effectively with diverse people, lead, back off or delegate as appropriate and be fellow sojourners on our journey of faith.
- 2. PASTORAL CARE Create and maintain effective pastor-member partnership in ministry and provide in-person consistent pastoral care.
- 3. EVANGELISM / BUILDING SENSE OF COM-MUNITY - Create and maintain strong spiritual leadership and a renewed focus on outreach.
- 4. PREACHING / WORSHIP Teach and preach the Gospel as it relates to life in the 21st century, especially with challenges of suffering, loss, grief, aging and health.
- 5. ADMINISTRATION Demonstrate strong organizational leadership and guidance while incorporating the input and contributions of others.

The Call Committee will continue to inform the congregation as our discernment process continues, and we ask the congregation to continue praying for the Call Committee, the call process and the Pastor candidates.

The Call Committee invites questions about the interview process itself, although candidate details must remain confidential. Please contact any of us: Jerry Class, Mary Erlenborn, Jeffrey Jenkins, Linda Juhasz, Mark Mendoza, Earline Trinkle, and Aaron Williams.
