Presentation content:

1 Block (3 min max): Natural wealth of the country/region (flora and fauna and specially protected natural areas)

2 Block (7 min max): Existing issues of environmental preservation and environmental management in the country/region, and ways to address them;

Participation of youth (from countries/regions) in the environmental preservation, environmental education and preservation programs and projects within the framework of various environmental activities, environmental organizations, associations and clubs;

Personal participation of the delegates in the submitted projects (their own studies, participation in the events, competitions and other activities with the environmental focus, volunteering activities, charities etc.);

Project implementation results.

Presentation language: English or Russian. Each UNESCO Associated School can present just one project.
