## **Additional Scholarship Information**

Approximately \$4,000 - \$5,000 in scholarship funds will be awarded.

All scholarships are for attendance at a high school level summer music camp for <u>instrumental</u> <u>music</u>: band, jazz band, orchestra, chamber music, piano or for <u>vocal music</u>: chorus, vocal jazz, musical theatre.

The recipient(s) will be selected on the basis of:

- Musical achievement as demonstrated by the results of an audition performed at The Music Foundation's annual scholarship audition event.
- Financial need is a consideration but not a requirement.
- The positive contributions you have made to the musical organization(s) of which you are a member.
- The Scholarship Application Form is filled out completely and all audition requirements are met.

The recipient must be able to be accepted and enrolled in the camp for the 2016 summer session. The scholarship award will be paid directly to the camp for the recipient's attendance.

Students who audition for any of the scholarships will also have the option of having their audition submitted to Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp for consideration for an additional scholarship award for Blue Lake's summer camp program.
