His First 30 Days!

- Trump signed the executive order formally ending the United States' participation in the Trans-Pacific Partnership in the Oval Office after discussing American manufacturing with business leaders in the Roosevelt Room. The order was largely symbolic the deal was already essentially dead in Congress but served to signal that Trump's tough talk on trade during the campaign will carry over to his new administration.
- We watched the new president move quickly to deliver on his promise to wipe out the funding for overseas abortion groups and redirect that money to real health care providers.
- President Trump signed executive orders effectively reviving the controversial Keystone XL and Dakota Access pipelines, as a major builder said it will reapply to build one of the projects which had been stalled by the Obama administration under pressure from environmental and other groups.
- President Donald Trump signed two executive orders in keeping with campaign promises to boost border security and crack down on immigrants living in the U.S. illegally.
- President Donald Trump signed executive orders for the U.S. Government to begin construction of a wall along the southern border with Mexico.
- President Donald Trump has signed 8
 executive orders. Barack Obama signed
 14 by this time.

- He has signed fourteen presidential memorandums and proclamations.
 - Includes directing the Treasury
 Secretary to review the "fiduciary
 rule," declaring February American
 Heart Month, directing his
 administration "to develop a
 comprehensive plan to defeat
 ISIS" and reorganizing the
 National Security Council.
- The President has had 8 Cabinet nominees confirmed.
- The number of jobs that United States employers have added in January is 227,000. It was the best job growth the country has seen since September.
- Federal government hiring freeze.
- Freezing regulations.
- Stopping sanctuary cities.
- He is rebuilding the military.
- They are working on boarder fence plans.
- Drafting plan to defeat ISIS.
- He brought about a 5 year lobbying ban.
- Nominated Judge Gorsuch to Supreme Court.

DID YOU KNOW?

Do You Have the Right Alabama ID?

Since 2005, federal authorities have been pushing for a nationwide identification program. It's part of an effort to keep the country secure from terrorism. It's just a matter of time before everyone will need to have this special ID, called a Real ID. Or, as Alabama calls it, the Star ID. But, as we found today, a surprising number of local people don't even know about it.

If you travel by air within the U.S. or enter federal buildings, by October 2020, you will need special identification to do so. Unless your Alabama drivers license has a yellow star on it, it won't be enough.

"I didn't know they existed at all."

"This is my first time ever hearing about it."

"I travel a lot....I've never seen it in the airports."

Those were some of the responses we heard today from people we spoke to at Railroad Park, who say these so-called new IDs are "news" to them. In 2005, Congress passed the Real ID Act, in response to the

911 terror attacks. The ID's are designed as an added security measure within the U.S. In addition to your full name, date of birth, address, and other key information, the new IDs will also include a bar code and special features to prevent tampering.

You also have to provide additional documentation to obtain these new IDs, including:

- One document for proof of identity
- Proof of all name change (if applicable)
- Proof of Social Security number
- Two proofs of Alabama address
- Completed application license or ID card

Right now, Alabama is one of only 25 states in the country considered "real ID compliant." That means currently, you can fly even without the star license. But, by the final deadline of October 2020, without the star you won't get in the air -- or inside the federal buildings.

Most arguments seem to revolve around the idea that the federal government will initiate a crackdown if states refuse to comply, and double-down on enforcement if states are unprepared to implement the mandate. Others suggest that a voluntary-opt out should placate all hostility toward the act, and prevent the possibility of privacy violations and centralized overreach. We have quite a few ladies going to Montgomery for Legislative Days. This is so exciting.


And as always, continue to pray for our country, wisdom for our President, the infighting going on and Israel.
