The Democrat Party is reaching out to our young people! It is vital that we do the same but BETTER!

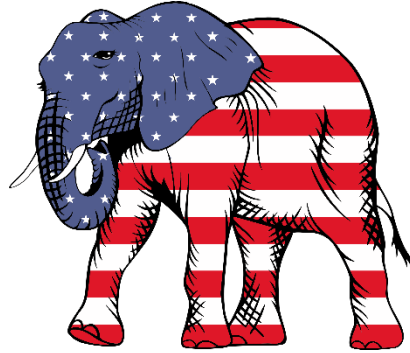

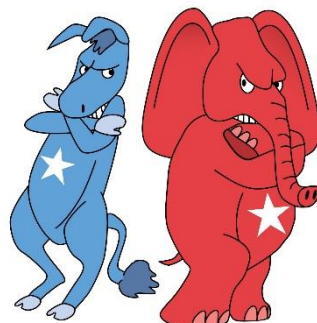
