

### Medytacja nad Słowem

Uczennica wybiera się tam, gdzie pozostawiono ciało jej Pana. Ale grób jest pusty. W tę ciemność wiary wpada promień światła. Choć na razie tłumaczenie faktu jest bardzo ludzkie: „Zabrano Pana z grobu i nie wiemy, gdzie Go złożono” (J 20, 2). Tymi słowami wrywa pozostałych uczniów z letargu smutku i lęku. Biegają, aby sprawdzić, czy rzeczywiście grób jest pusty. Wierzą, choć nie pojmują. Tę wiarę przekazali również każdemu z nas. Wiara Kościoła w fakt zmartwychwstania wrywa i mnie z marazmu i wnosi światło w różne ospałe przestrzenie mojego życia. Ja też mogę uwolnić się od lęku i zwątpienia, bo Chrystus prawdziwie zmartwychwstał.

*Dozwól, Panie, by pełna zdumienia radość zmartwychwstania przeniknęła moje myśli, spojrzenia, słowa i działania. Niech mojeserce zanurzy się w źródle tej niewypowiedzianej radości!*

**Alleluja! Radujmy się! Pan zmartwychwstał!**



*Wielkanoc to bardzo radosne święto. Cieszymy się, że Chrystus pokonał śmierć. Daję to i nam nadzieję, że i my kiedyś powstaniemy z martwych, że nie zostaniemy unicestwieni. Gdyby Chrystus nie zmartwychwstał, próżna byłaby nasza wiara — pisze apostoł Paweł (por. 1 Kor 15,14).
