Medytacja nad Słowem

Uczniowie zamknięci w Wieczerniku. W ich sercach smutek i beznadzieja po śmierci Jezusa. Więcej nawet: lęk przed tym, by nie spotkał ich taki sam los, co Mistrza. Zmartwychwstały wchodzi przez zamknięte drzwi i udziela im swojego pokoju. A przez nich swój pokój pozostawia Kościołowi, napełniając apostołów Duchem Świętym. Mocą z wysoka, która oczyszcza serce człowieka i wiąże go na nowo z Bogiem. Tak dzieje się w każdym sakramencie pokuty. Grzech nie ma mocy powstrzymania Boga przed udzieleniem nam swojego pokoju. Duch, dar Zmartwychwstałego, staje się ogniem miłości wypalającym to wszystko, co było jej zaprzeczeniem. Bóg w swoim miłosierdziu przypomina nam, że ten dar zawsze jest dostępny w Kościele.

Wysławiam Cię, Ojczy, Panie nieba i ziemi, że w swoim Synu czynisz mnie uczestnikiem Twojego pokoju. Uwielbiam Cię w tym darze i proszę, przymnóż mi wiary!

„Święto to wyszło z wnętrzości miłosierdzia mojego i jest zatwierdzone w głębokościach zmiłowań moich. Wszelka dusza wierząca i ufająca miłosierdziu mojemu – dostąpi go”.

W następnych latach Pan Jezus powracał do tego żądania aż 14 razy, określając miejsce tego święta w kalendarzu liturgicznym, przyczynę i cel jego ustanowienia oraz sposób przygotowania i obchodzenia.
