PIERWSZE CZYTANIE: Rdz 14, 18-20

DRUGIE CZYTANIE: 1 Kor 11, 23-26

EWANGELIA: Łk 9, 11 b-17

Medytacja nad Słowem

Królestwo Jezusa od dwóch tysięcy lat jest pośród nas, dostępne dla każdego. Jezus pozostał jako prawdziwy i dający życie Pokarm, zaspokajający głód prawdy i miłości. Jego słowa wskazują drogę do królestwa, a Jego rzeczywiste przebywanie w Komunii św. jest obecnością dającą moc na wędrówanie i zaspokajającą wszelki prawdziwy głód człowieka. Człowiek powinien podejmować wysiłek odkrywania tych pragnień, które świadczą o powołaniu do wiecznej pełni. Stąd trzeba, aby na każdą Mszę św. szedł prawdziwie głodny. I nie tylko o post eucharystyczny tu chodzi, lecz przede wszystkim o rezygnację z duchowych fast foodów. Tylko Eucharystia jest pokarmem prawdziwej, sycącej Miłości. Miłości, której wystarczy dla wszystkich, którą można karmić innych. Zwłaszcza tych cierpiących, którzy nie odkryli prawdziwego głodu człowieka.

Niechaj będzie pochwalony Przenajświętszy Sakrament! Niech będzie uwielbiony Bóg, który dał samego siebie w cudownie przemieniającym Pokarmie.

Boże Ciało - uroczystość Najświętszego Ciała i Krwi Chrystusa

Uroczystość Najświętszego Ciała i Krwi Chrystusa, Boże Ciało jest jednym z głównych świąt obchodzonych w Kościele katolickim. Choć świadomość niezwykłego cudu przemiany konsekrowanego chleba i wina w rzeczywiste Ciało i Krew Chrystusa towarzyszyła wiernym od początku chrześcijaństwa, jednak trzeba było czekać aż dziesięć stuleci zanim zewnętrzne przejawy tego kultu powstały i zadomowiły się w Kościele katolickim.



Katechizm Kościoła Katolickiego mówi, iż "sposób obecności Chrystusa pod postaciami eucharystycznymi jest wyjątkowy... W Najświętszym Sakramencie Eucharystii są zawarte prawdziwie, rzeczywiście i substancjalnie Ciało i Krew wraz z duszą i Bóstwem Pana naszego Jezusa Chrystusa, a więc cały Chrystus." (KKK 1374).
