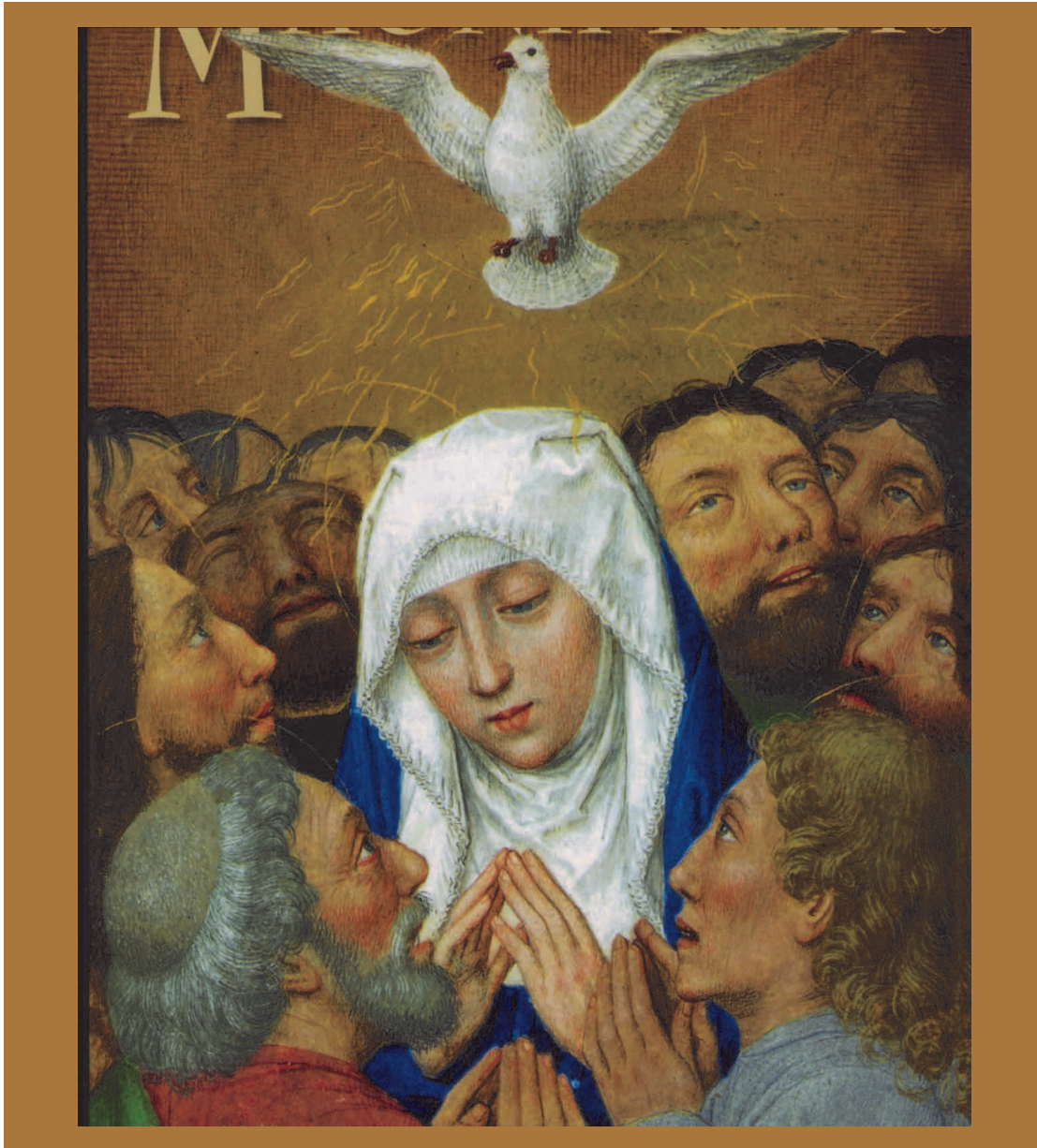

PIERWSZE CZYTANIE: Koh 1, 2;2, 21-23

DRUGIE CZYTANIE: Kol 3,1-5.9-11

EWANGELIA: Łk 12,13-21

Medytacja nad Słowem

Jezus uczy dziś właściwego spojrzenia na relację pomiędzy pragnieniem szczęścia w życiu a dobrami materialnymi. Wartość tych ostatnich mierzy się sposobem ich użycia. One nie mogą przeszkadzać w szukaniu prawdziwego bogactwa, które czyni ludzi bogatymi przed Bogiem. W obecnych czasach łatwo stać się wyznawcą religii posiadania, która może zniewolić każdego. Bożki majątku, chciwości, zazdrości i zawiści pojawiają się na firmamentach. Kuszące reklamy przekonują, że ludzka wartość zależy od posiadania różnych rzeczy, zniewalają nas. Tymczasem prawdziwa wolność przychodzi w Bogu, ponieważ On jest jedynym Panem mojej przyszłości.
