

Medytacja nad Słowem

Każdy, kto ma świadomość, jak wielkie i niewysłowione są Boże dary udzielone nam w Chrystusie, chciałby je jak najlepiej przyjąć i jak najowocniej spożytkować, aby w ten sposób oddać chwałę Bogu i uczynić swoje życie szczęśliwe. Jezus dziś mówi: "Szczęśliwi słudzy, których pan zastanie czuwających, gdy przyjdzie" (Łk 12, 37). Dziwna może się wydawać ta Jezusowa recepta na szczęście. Czuwanie kojarzy się przecież z życiem w napięciu, w ciągłym niepokoju. Ale ta recepta pochodzi od Jezusa, nie jest ludzkim wymysłem. To w pewien sposób egzamin z wiary, która musi być nieustannie poddawana próbom, aby stawała się coraz mocniejszym fundamentem dla gmachu życia, nie tylko własnego. Wiara w obietnice Jezusa oczyszcza niepewność czuwania z pomysłów budowania królestwa tu, na ziemi. Uczy właściwych kryteriów oceny rzeczywistości i działania. Służyć, czyli realizować to, co Bóg mi powierzył, to najlepszy sposób na szczęście.

Boże Ojcze, który nie wahałeś się oddać swojego Syna, jakże nie miałbyś mi dać wszystkiego w Nim! Pomóż mi zachować czujność serca, abym zawsze był wdzięczny za udzielone dary.
