Każdy, kto ma świadomość, jak wielkie i niewysłowione są Boże dary udzielone nam w Chrystusie, chciałby je jak najlepiej przyjąć i jak najowocniej spożytkować, aby w ten sposób oddać chwałę Bogu i uczynić swoje życie szczęśliwe. Jezus dziś mówi: „Szczęśliwi słudzy, których pan zastanie czuwających, gdy przyjdzie” (Łk 12, 37). Dziwna może się wydawać ta Jezusowa recepta na szczęście.
