



PIERWSZE CZYTANIE: Jr 20,7–9

DRUGIE CZYTANIE:Rz 12,1-2

EWANGELIA : Mt 16,21–27

#### Medytacja nad Słowem

Myślenie po ludzku, zamiast po Bożemu, jest pierwszym skutkiem grzechu pierworodnego. Tak naprawdę grzech pierworodny polega na tym, że człowiek ma poodwracane pragnienia, że pragnie tego, co złe, zamiast tego, co dobre, że jest nastawiony "na", oczekuje, spodziewa się, marzy o tym, co wcale nie przyniesie mu szczęścia. To jest skutek grzechu pierworodnego i Święty Piotr udowadnia nam to dzisiaj, mówiąc do Jezusa: Nie chciałbym, żebyś realizował plany swojego Ojca, wolałbym, żebyś zrealizował moje ludzkie plany. Dlatego usłyszał od Jezusa, że jest przeszkoda. Wszyscy mamy prawo błądzić, mówić Bogu: Pomyliłem się. Moje marzenia, pragnienia są złe. Nie wolno nam jednak stawiać naszych planów ponad plany Boga.
