



On Peace and Justice

On Thursday August 24th, I was able to attend St. James Cathedral of our Diocese to participate in the liturgy entitled: "Peace and Solidarity". The homily given by Bishop DiMarzio that evening focused on recent violent attacks in Barcelona, Spain and Charlottesville, Virginia.

I can still hear his voice echoing in my ears for the courageous words the bishop gave that night to over 300 lay people, bishops, priests and deacons resonating so much of the discouragement of terrorism which pervades the atmosphere of the world. Unfortunately, we have our own home-grown terrorism which focuses on discrimination, separatism and violence, precipitated by bigotry and racism.

I quote an excerpt from Bishop DiMarzio (Tablet text - Sept. 2, 2017):

"Racism remains the preeminent sin of not only our Nation, but also of our Church. In 1979, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops issued a statement called, Brothers and Sisters to Us. The statement begins by saying, "Racism is an evil which endures in our society and in our Church. Despite apparent advances and even significant change in the last two decades, the reality of racism remains. In large part it is only external appearances which have changed."

How important it is to recognize that racism, as the Bishops went on to say, "is not merely one sin among many; it is a radical evil that divides the human family and denies the new creation of a redeemed world. To struggle against it demands an equally radical transformation, in our own minds and hearts as well as the structure of our society." Yes, we must look for radical change.

To the extent that racism affects even our diocese, Bishop DiMarzio that evening announced the establishment of a diocesan commission for Social Justice, named after Msgr. Bernard Quinn who was victimized and whose life was threatened by the Ku Klux Klan for having worked with Afro-Americans in our Diocese in the early part of the twentieth century (ca. 1922). *Fr. Anthony*

In Memoriam - Msgr. George Michael Schuster


On December 3, 2017 we will celebrate the first anniversary of Msgr. George M. Schuster's passing from this life into the Kingdom of the Father.

Msgr. Schuster was the fifth pastor assigned by the bishop to administrate and care for the spiritual and pastoral welfare of the people of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal Parish. To many of us and personally me his passing is greatly felt.

Upon my arrival, I noticed in the church, bronze plaques at the entrance depicting the previous four pastors and the dates of their administration and specific information pertaining to their time spent in our parish. I did not want the year of our Centennial, nor of Msgr. Schuster's anniversary to go by without well due recognition of one who spent more than twenty years serving both as pastor and pastor emeritus at OLMM.

On Sunday December 3rd of this year, which marks Msgr. Schuster's passing, at the 10:30am Mass, we will unveil a bronze plaque in his memory. I hope that many of you will be present for this liturgy.
