





#### **Progress Report**

#### **Decorating and Painting of our Church**

Almost six months have passed since work began, which seems like a long time. However, each day that I spend watching the progress of what is happening, I am more amazed at the dimensions of this sacred space and the quality found in every twist and turn of where corners meet, columns rise, ledges appear, and inspirational art is displayed. What a wonderful place to celebrate the Eucharist.

You may have noticed some of these particular paintings brought back to life again:

- 1) Our Lady of the Assumption over the interior doors (west wall), which is further enhanced with a three dimensional gold frame and double
- 1-e-d lighting under the organ loft.
- 2) The Crowning of Our Lady Queen of Heaven (south wall Bleecker St.), darkened and dull by time and age presents us with the fifth glorious mystery of the rosary in all its power and splendor.
- 3) The appearance of Our Lady and the child Jesus to St. Catherine Laboure' leading to devotion of the Miraculous Medal (north wall). This is the most vivid of the paintings, neglected for many decades, and faces the shrine and altar of the Miraculous Medal which has also been restored. I might add there is more detailed work to be done at the shrine-altar.
- 4) I also bring to your attention the altarshrine to St. Joseph and newly restored gold baldachino. Very often this is overlooked because it is hidden on the south side of the church (Bleecker St.).

As we continue, I will bring you up to date as to further details of the restoration and painting. Sincere thanks to our parishioners for your patience with the scaffolds. We try to keep all of this restricted for the liturgies on the weekend.
