PIERWSZE CZYTANIE: Rdz 9,8-15

DRUGIE CZYTANIE: 1 P 3,18-22

EWANGELIA : Mk 1,12-15

Medytacja nad Słowem

Święty Marek w jednym zdaniu swojej Ewangelii zawarł czterdzieści trudnych dni zmagania Jezusa na pustyni. Czterdzieści długich dni i nocy samotności, prób i walki. W pokusie najgorszą rzeczą jest uznanie, że jesteśmy sami. Tak nie jest! Właśnie wtedy Bóg wyciąga do nas swoją rękę, walcząc razem z nami. Jest szczególnie blisko, choć nasze przeczucie może temu przeczyć. On jednak nigdy nie zostawia swoich dzieci w niebezpieczeństwie. Chrystus, który sam walczył na pustyni, wie przecież doskonale, że tylko z Nim możemy skutecznie pokonać pokusy i zło.

Moja pomoc w imieniu Pana! Mój ratunek i moja siła są w Tobie, Panie Jezu. Bądź przy mnie w trudnych doświadczeniach i próbach. Umacniaj mnie Twoją łaską.

Po co nam Wielki Post? - Nowe Życie

Wielki 40-dniowy post rozpoczęliśmy w środę popielcową od symbolicznego znaku krzyża na czole popiołem. Jest on symbolem kruchości i przemijalności ludzkiego życia, ale także znakiem żałoby i pokuty. Znak ten ma ogromne znaczenie dla przeżywania Wielkiego Postu. Każdy, kto ten znak uczynił na czole popiołem przyznaje przed Bogiem, że jest grzeszny i pragnie prawdziwego nawrócenia.

Gorzkie Żale to popularne w Polsce nabożeństwo pasyjne, połączone z wystawieniem Najświętszego Sakramentu kazaniem pasyjnym. Pochodzi ono z początków XVIII w. - po raz pierwszy odprawiono je w 1707 r. Jego tekst zachował oryginalne, staropolskie brzmienie. Gorzkie żale są tradycją wyłącznie polską. **Zapraszamy na wspólną modlitwę w każdą niedzielę podczas wielkiego postu na godz 2pm.**
