

Wielkanoc jest zaproszeniem, aby nie tylko słuchać Jezusa i Jego uczniów opowiadających o tym, co się stało, ale aby doświadczyć we własnym życiu tego światła, tej nadziei i tej radości, których źródłem może być tylko zmartwychwstały Pan.
