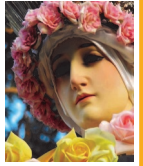

Czytania na Niedzielę 6 maja 2018

PIERWSZE CZYTANIE: Dz 10,25-26.34-35.44-48

DRUGIE CZYTANIE: 1 J 4,7-10

EWANGELIA: J 15,9-17

Medytacja nad Słowem

Szczerą i głęboką miłość do Boga zaczyna się od miłości do bliźniego. Dlatego najpierw powinniśmy prawdziwie pokochać tych, którzy są najbliższymi – naszą rodzinę. Dopiero wówczas to uczucie będziemy w stanie rozszerzać na innych. Łatwo bowiem kochać na odległość, deklarować przyjaźń wobec tych, co są daleko. Najbliższych miłować jest zawsze najtrudniej. Żyjąc pod jednym dachem, obrastamy we wzajemne pretensje, żale, winy... Wobec najbliższych często czujemy się usprawiedliwieni z naszej obojętności i skamieniałego serca. Znając ich wady i słabości, potrafimy też boleśnie zranić.

Panie Jezu, proszę dziś o pogłębienie miłości w mojej rodzinie. Pomóż nam wzrastać we wzajemnym zrozumieniu, ucz szacunku do siebie, życzliwości. Daj łaskę przebaczenia. Dziękuję Ci, Boże, za wszystkich moich bliskich.-

Katechizm Kościoła Katolickiego – Miłość

KKK 1822 Miłość jest cnotą teologalną, dzięki której miłujemy Boga nade wszystko dla Niego samego, a naszych bliźnich jak siebie samych ze względu na miłość Boga.

KKK 1823 Jezus czyni miłość przedmiotem nowego przykazania (Por. J 13, 34). Umiłowawszy swoich "do końca" (J 13, 1), objawia miłość Ojca, którą od Niego otrzymuje. Uczniowie miłując się wzajemnie, naśladują miłość Jezusa, którą także sami otrzymują. Dlatego Jezus mówi: "Jak Mnie umiłowal Ojciec, tak i Ja was umiłowalem. Wytrwajcie w miłości mojej!" (J 15, 9). I jeszcze: "To jest moje przykazanie, abyście się wzajemnie miłowali, tak jak Ja was umiłowalem" (J 15,12).
