Pope Francis: A Man of his Word

As a prelude to last week's release of the edocumentary film: 'Pope Francis - A Man of his Word', CBS News 60 M in utes interviewed Pope

Francis for a 20 minute segment on Sunday, May 13th.

Last week's bulletin summarized a response of the Holy Father regarding the unrest existing in women and men of our time in the culture and societies of the world.

What does the first pope of the Americas, the first pope from the Southern Hemisphere, the first Jesuit pope, and the first pope to take the name Francis have to say about the environment and poverty.

From this interview with, Wim Wenders and Jon Wertheim, we gather the radical nature by which the pope chose the name Francis taken from the 13th century saint of the environment and the saint of the poor. In fact, Pope Francis devoted his second Encyclical 'Laudato Si' (taken from the Canticle of St. Francis of Assisi, meaning: Praised be to You, My Lord) to technology, science and data behind the climate change. This pope speaks openly about evolution, and says, quote, "The biblical story of creation is a mythical form of expression." He likens the neglect of the Earth to the neglect of the poor.

They go together. And if today you ask me: for you, who is the poorest of the poorest of the poor? I would say: Mother Earth!" We have plundered her! We have abused her! And we are all responsible! No one can say: "I have nothing to do with this".

By victimizing the Earth, not respecting the planet, polluting the environment of air, water and soil we have also victimized people. We caused them to become poor, in mind, body and soul. The inability to have clean air to breathe, clean water to drink, acres of waste poisoning the soil, not permitting planting; thereby destroying organic food products aims at the very core of peoples' need to survive.
