PIERWSZE CZYTANIE: Jr 23,1-6 DRUGIE CZYTANIE: Ef 2,13-18 EWANGELIA: Mk 6,30-34

Medytacja nad Słowem

Jedną z form spotkania ze słowem Bożym jest wyobrażenie sobie sytuacji opisywanych na kartach Pisma Świętego i postawienie siebie samego wewnątrz opowieści. Święty Ignacy Loyola, który proponował praktykowanie tej formy medytacji, zachęcał, by uruchomić w niej wszystkie swoje zmysły. Oto ja jestem jednym z uczniów, którzy wracają do Jezusa po całym dniu pracy. Widzę pełen ciekawości wzrok Jezusa, zainteresowanie tym, jak było. Doświadczam współczucia, które mi okazuje.
