PIERWSZE CZYTANIE: Wj 16,2-4.12-15

DRUGIE CZYTANIE: Ef 4,17.20-24

EWANGELIA : J 6,24-35

Medytacja nad Słowem

Szukacie Mnie nie dlatego, że zobaczyliście znaki, lecz dlatego, że najedliście się chleba do syta” (J 6, 26) – wyrzut Jezusa skierowany do ludzi, którzy dopiero co byli świadkami cudownego rozmnożenia chleba, warto potraktować poważnie, kiedy doświadczają się pokusy instrumentalnego traktowania spraw Bożych. Można szukać Jezusa nie dla Niego samego, ale dla osiągnięcia doczesnych korzyści. Można też garnąć się do Kościoła, nie pragnąc spotkać w nim Boga. Jest to częsta pokusa. Tymczasem Chrystus, objawiając moc i udzielając obficie swoich łask, pragnie, by naszą odpowiedzią na nie była wiara. Dlatego prosząc Go o zdrowie ciała, pomyśl o zdrowiu swej duszy, modląc się o pomyślność w interesach, zatroszcz się, by dobra materialne nie przysłoniły ci duchowych skarbów.

Dobry Jezu, oczyść moje serce z nieuporządkowanych pragnień. Oby Duch Święty sprawił, bym kierował się w swoim postępowaniu miłością i wiarą.

KATECHIZM KOŚCIOŁA KATOLICKIEGO O EUCHARYSTII

Eucharystia - źródło i szczyt życia Kościoła

1324 Eucharystia jest "źródłem i zarazem szczytem całego życia chrześcijańskiego" "Inne zaś sakramenty, tak jak wszystkie kościelne posługi i dzieła apostołstwa, wiążą się ze świętą Eucharystią i do niej zbiegają. W Najświętszej bowiem Eucharystii zawiera się całe duchowe dobro Kościoła, a mianowicie sam Chrystus, nasza Pascha".

1325 "Eucharystia oznacza i urzeczywistnia komunij życia z Bogiem i jedność Ludu Bożego, przez które Kościół jest sobą. Jest ona szczytem działania, przez które Bóg w Chrystusie uświęca świat, a równocześnie szczytem kultu, jaki ludzie w Duchu Świętym oddają Chrystusowi, a przez Niego Ojcu".
