PIERWSZE CZYTANIE: Iz 50,5-9a DRUGIE CZYTANIE: Jk 2,14-18 EWANGELIA: Mk 8,27-35

Medytacja nad Słowem

"Według was, kim jestem?" – pyta Jezus swoich uczniów. Pyta i nas. To nie jest egzamin z wiedzy religijnej, podczas którego możemy pochwalić się swoją znajomością różnych teorii na temat Chrystusa albo zawstydzić własną ignorancją. To pytanie bardzo osobiste i mające charakter decydujący: Kim jestem dla ciebie teraz, w tym momencie twojego życia? Jezus nie pyta, co o Nim słyszeliśmy, czego nas nauczono na katechezie, co o Nim kiedyś myśleliśmy. Pyta o teraz! Tak jak żonę pytającą męża o miłość interesuje "teraz" ich relacji, a nie to, co było przed laty.
