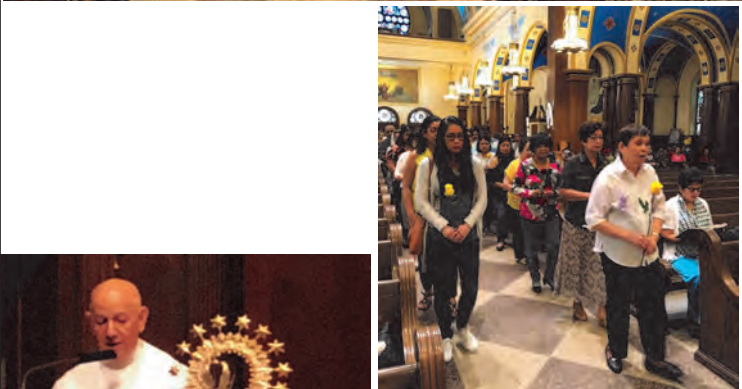

Medytacja nad Słowem

„Jeśli ktoś chce być pierwszy...” (Mk 9, 35). Testy, rankingi, plebiscyty – wszystko po to, by wskazać najlepszych i zawstydzić tych, co się nie załapali. Tak wiele od siebie wymagamy, by nie być tymi ostatnimi. I nierzadko płacimy wysoką cenę za sukces. A może warto zacząć pielęgnować w sobie skromność i umiarkowanie? Naturalna, zwyczajna przeciętność została dziś ograbiona z szacunku. A przecież starożytni filozofowie powtarzali: in mediavirtus – ‘cnota leży pośrodku’. Nie wstydzmy się zdrowej przeciętności.
