

PIERWSZE CZYTANIE: 1Krl 17,10-16 DRUGIE CZYTANIE: Hbr 9, 24-28 EWANGELIA: Mk 12, 38-44

Medytacja nad Słowem

Uboga kobieta wrzuciła do skarbony wszystko, co miała. Podziwiamy jej postawę, zwłaszcza że sam Jezus dał ja uczniom za przykład. Z drugiej strony możemy się zastanawiać, czy postąpiła roztropnie. Skarbiec świątynny niewiele się wzbogacił jej drobną ofiarą, a ona pozostała bez środków do życia. W takim myśleniu ukryta jest pewna forma kalkulacji, obca ewangelicznej postawie miłości, która "nie szuka siebie" (1 Kor 13, 5). Do ubogiej wdowy podobne są osoby, które opiekują się kimś chorym lub niedołężnym, ofiarując swój czas, siły i pieniądze. Czują, że w taki sposób wypełniają obowiązek miłości cierpliwej i szlachetnej (por. 1 Kor 13, 4). Wdowim groszem jest przebaczenie i danie komuś kolejnej szansy, bo miłość "nie liczy doznanych krzywd" (1 Kor 13, 5), albo uczciwość, kiedy znajomi proponują zarobek na lewo. W końcu miłość "nie cieszy się z niesprawiedliwości, lecz raduje się prawdą" (1 Kor 13, 6).

Panie Jezu, dając mi za przykład ubogą wdowę, uczysz mnie prawdziwej miłości. Umocnij we mnie ducha ofiarności, bym w ten sposób był coraz bardziej podobny do Ciebie.




