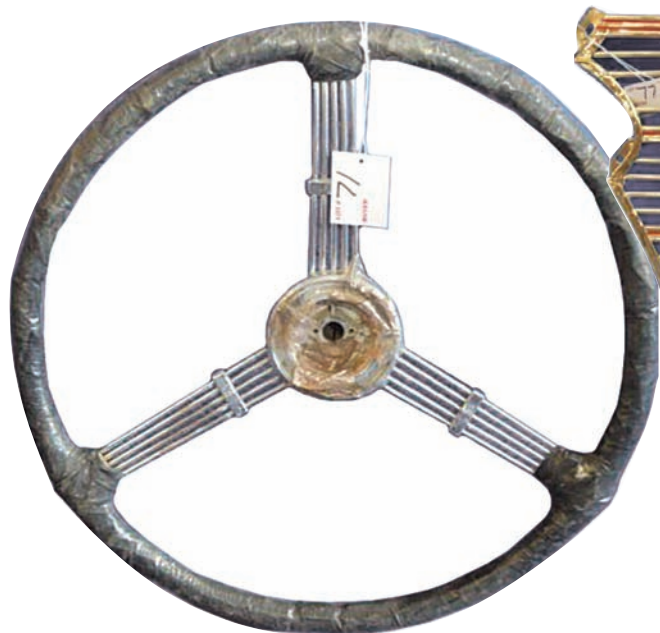

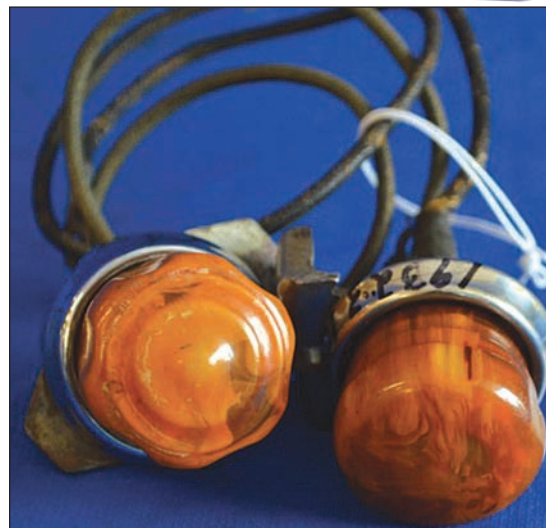

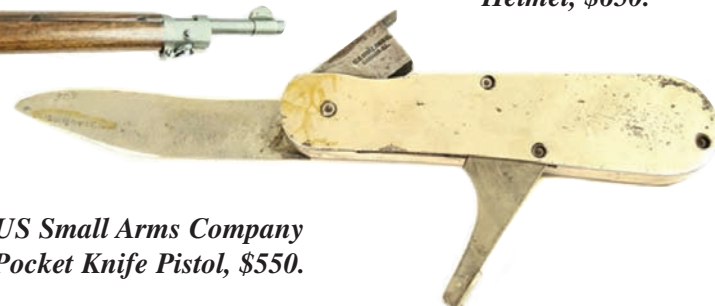

This display will explore the important transition of Canvasback hunting from Minnesota to Manitoba driven by habitat and environmental changes. The display will feature early decoys made by area makers such as Joe Marr in Minnesota, and the Ducharme, Ward and Chartrand families in Manitoba. This is just one of many exciting displays, exhibits and activities available to attendees of the April 26-27 dealer show in the Mega Center.

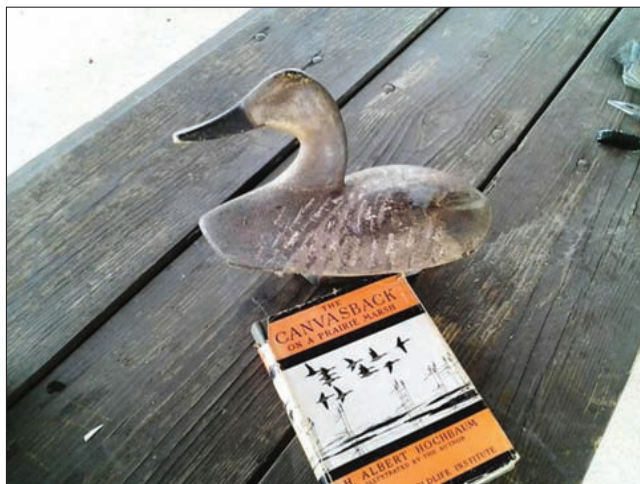
On Thursday, April 25, at 8:30am, attendees will also be able to learn more about the fascinating history of the Delta Marsh and the Delta Waterfowl Foundation's ongoing research to help sustain this rich breeding area. Pay Gregory, decoy maker and historian, and Paul Wait, Editor/Publisher of Delta Waterfowl magazine, will talk about their recent traditional hunts on marsh using vintage decoys.
