



Antigo Visual Arts of Antigo, Wisconsin is sponsoring a benefit Art Auction to benefit the Langlade County Historical Museum building fund and the Museums AVA Art Gallery. This Art Auction is a first for Antigo.

Auctioneer Jerry Chuilli with ringman John Carbonari will be auctioning the art of Nationally known local artists Frank Vavruska 1917-1976, A Guggenheim Fellowship recipient who is known for his abstract mid century art and artist George Falkenhagen 1890-1958, known for his lake and landscape art.



Frank Vavruska, a world traveler was born in Antigo, Wisconsin studied Art in The University of Wisconsin and the Institute Art Chicago where he was awarded the Reyerson Traveling Fellowship which enabled him to paint and travel through-

out Mexico. While Hospitalized in England in the US Army during WW II Frank produced many paintings for which he was awarded the Guggenheim Fellowship. Vavruska started out in expressionist and cubist art moved Who was Frank Vavruska?

In 1961, with the cooperation of the Archeological Museum of Campeche, Mexico, he began making a series of rubbings from the Mayan carved stone reliefs. In the process, he developed an original and personal rubbing technique.

The work of four years at the museums of Campeche, Merida, and archeological sites of Dzibilchaltum, Chichen Itza, Bonampak and Palenge resulted in a collection of 86 rubbings which form a unique record of historical importance.

In the late 60's, inspired by rubbings he had made of landmark archeological sites in Mexico, Vavruska began to make paintings based on rubbings of Chicago manhole covers, which the press dubbed "sewerrealism." Much too young, Vavruska died in 1974 at

Frank Vavruska was born in 1917 in Antigo, Wisconsin. He studied art at The University of Wisconsin and the Art Institute of Chicago, where he was awarded the Ryerson Traveling Fellowship, which enabled him to paint and travel in Mexico.

While hospitalized in England in the US Army during WWII, Vavruska produced many paintings which were the basis for a Guggenheim Fellowship.

Primarily based in Chicago, Vavruska was a nomad at heart. He worked for two years in the Yucatan Peninsula, was commissioned to make a mural for the Archeological Museum in Campeche, and developed an avid interest in the archeological richness of the region. Vavruska lived in Europe for six years, mainly in Southern France, and he traveled in North Africa, Italy, Paris, and spent a year in London.

In the late 40's, his work began to shift from its expressionist and cubist figurative basis towards a purer form of abstractionism. Another point of reference during this period, Vavruska temporarily relocated from Chicago to New York where his beautiful, rough abstract paintings were included in exhibitions at the Metropolitan, Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts, Madison Square Garden, and elsewhere.

toward the abstract in the 1940's.

George Falkenhagen, a self taught artist moved to Antigo from Chicago at 17 in 1907. After school George worked for local sign shops. After serving in the Army in WWI he returned to Antigo and set off in a quest to paint north woods' lakes and scenery. He said the most beautiful

place in the world is the lake regions of the Midwest especially Minnesota and Wisconsin.

The Vavruska Family made a gift of Frank Vavruska art, his Mayan rubbings and antiquities to the Antigo Visual Arts.

Now it's time for this gift of art to be shared and appreciated for a worthy cause. In addition to the work of Vavruska and Falkenhagen this Auction also features the Art from our very own award winning members of Antigo Visual Arts. There's original pottery, wood turnings, watercolors, paintings, photography, metal work and other original artwork to be auctioned.


