The history-rich town of Arthur, Illinois once again hosted what's become one of the most popular country antiques events in the Midwest: the Fourteenth Annual A Gathering on the Prairie Spring Antiques Show. Located in the middle of Illinois' Amish Country, Arthur is a perfect place for the show, whose fifty dealers all specialize in American primitive & country antiques. The quiet town is anything but on the first Saturday of each March, when the one-day event is always held. In fact there's something to do almost any weekend in Arthur, which draws more than a hundred-thousand visitors each year to its many shows and festivals.

Arthur, Illinois' A Gathering on the Prairie Antiques Show: The One That Started it All!

I don't think anyone in the antiques trade can deny that in the last fourteen years, the spring and autumn Arthur, Illinois Antiques Weekends have firmly established themselves as one of the Midwest's finest antiques traditions. And the show that started all the fuss was the A Gathering on the Prairie Antiques Show, founded back in 2003.

Area antiques dealer Donna Kibler now runs the event. She was one of those dealers who displayed at the very first A Gathering on the Prairie Antiques Show. "I think we had around two dozen dealers at that inaugural show" Donna told me, "and many of them have returned to every show since." The show has more than doubled in size over the years, and now boasts around fifty dealers from eight states.

The picturesque town of Arthur is natural location for the country & primitives-themed show. Right in the heart of central Illinois' Amish Country, Arthur's 2,200 citizens are surrounded by the oldest and largest Amish settlement in the state, founded in the 1860s and now numbering nearly 5,000 strong. It was a busy Saturday indeed in Arthur on the day of the show, with much of the traffic headed to the Otto Center, host of the A Gathering on the Prairie Antiques Show.

North Carolina's Jay & Carole Harper were among the dealers. They brought a wide variety of classic American country furnishings and artifacts of daily life. I found a wonderful 19th century Winston-Salem Moravian sugar chest there, sporting its original pale pumpkin finish. And decorated American stoneware is always the focus at Stephen F. Rhodes Antiques, where shoppers found examples of all

sizes, shapes, and prices.

Folk art more your thing? Look no farther than Painted Pony Country Primitives, in whose booth stood two icons from the American Civil War: arch-enemy Generals Grant and Lee. Well, vintage folky carved representations of them, both around 2' tall and priced at only \$375 for the pair. And folk art of all sorts could be had at Missouri plain Folk, including important examples of the early painted game boards they're best known for. In fact, you'll find exhibitors here with every category of country & primitives, from textiles and tools to lighting, toys, and more.

This Spring Antiques Weekend in Arthur was just the beginning of their 2016 events. May brings the Amish Country Quilt Show, followed by the Moultrie-Douglas Combined County Fair in July. And tens of thousands of visitors come each Labor Day Weekend for the Amish Country Cheese Festival. Just visit www.illinoisamishcountry.com for all the details of those events and more.

The A Gathering on the Prairie Antiques Show has been so successful that it has spawned several other area antiques shows, all taking place on the same weekend. And don't worry if you missed this spring edition of the show: there's a fall Gathering on the Prairie Antiques Show as well, right here at the Otto Center in Arthur this November 12th - the anchor show to the town's Autumn Antiques Weekend. When you go to their website, www.agatheringontheprairie.com, be sure to join their email notification list so you won't forget. And as always, keep an eye out for all of the A Gathering on the Prairie Antiques Shows in the Auction Action Antique News!

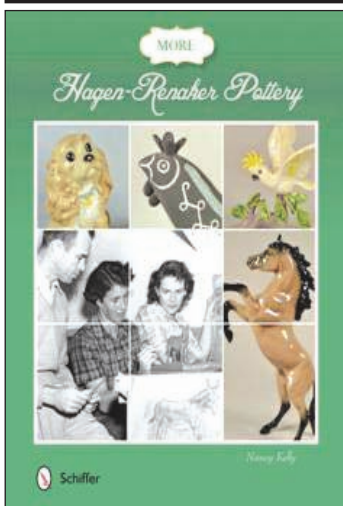

And The Two Shall Become One Blue & White Pottery /Old Sleepy Eye Collectors Club

In 1981 a group of friends, all interested in blue and white stoneware in the Cedar Rapids, Iowa area got together and decided to "Start a New Club. They based their Constitution and Bylaws on what the Sleepy Eye Club was governed by, modifying it to work for them. Everyone liked the Swan pitcher, so they collectively chose that as the official logo for the Club. They registered the Blue & White Pottery Club as a non-profit organization. They advertised the club in every antique trade magazine. The advertising worked beautifully and the memberships began pouring in at \$10 per person and another \$1 for each additional person in the household, making members eligible to attend a two day convention and receive a quarterly newsletter. The very first newsletter dated August 1981 boasted 104 members from 17 states! The advertising continued to enlist new members proving the widespread love of Blue and White stoneware everywhere.

Old Sleepy Eye Collectors Club Amid the idyllic setting of the Martin farm near Monmouth, Il, a small group of Old Sleepy Eye collectors met in January 1976 to discuss the formation of a club. By the end of the meeting the Old Sleepy Eye Collectors Club of America, Inc. was formed and soon after chartered as a non-profit organization. Monmouth is the home of the Western Stoneware Co., which produced the first four stoneware pieces of

Old Sleepy Eye pottery for the Sleepy Eye Milling Co that were put into sacks of flour. On March 24, 1976, the newly formed Old Sleepy Eye Collectors Club published its first newsletter. Since that humble beginning the club has grown throughout the years. A convention was held every year thereafter with the last convention being held in Sleepy Eye, MN in 2015. Conventions were held in many different cities in the Midwest.

On June 12, 2015 at the 34th annual convention, members of the Blue & White Pottery Club voted to merge their club with Old Sleepy Eye Collectors Club. Then on July 31, 2015 at the 40th consecutive convention the membership of the Old Sleepy Eye Collectors Club voted to join with the Blue & White Pottery Club.

Both clubs joining together from this day forward will be known as, Blue & White Pottery/Old Sleepy Eye Collectors Club, (BWPOSECC). This merger is following modern day trends to get bigger and better with more recognition of the beautiful items that both club's represent to avid collectors of history.

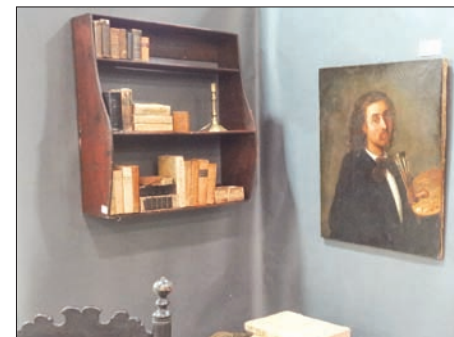
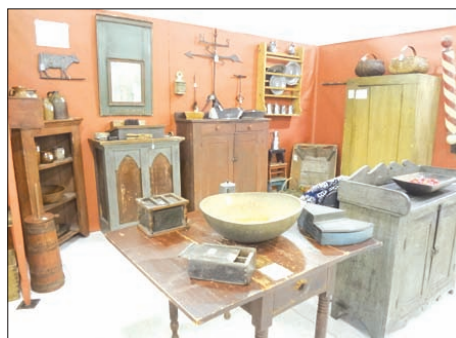

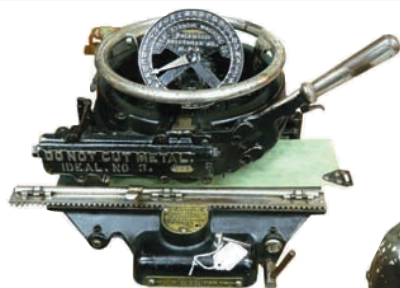
