



## The 51st Annual National Vintage Decoy & Sporting Collectibles Show – Granddaddy of Them All

It was way back in 1966 when a small group of decoy collectors got together and formed the Midwest Decoy Collectors Association - and held their first show in that same year. Now more than a half-century later, the Midwest Decoy Collectors Association has grown to be a truly international organization, with more than 1,000 members from all fifty states, Canada, and Mexico. Other members hail from as far away as England, Switzerland, and Japan. Their annual show - the National Vintage Decoy & Sporting Collectibles Show - has grown right along with the association, and has become the largest and most important decoy & sporting collectibles show in North America.





# It's a Sea of Decoys at the 51st Annual MDCA National Vintage Decoy & Sporting Collectibles Show!

At this year's event, held on April 22nd & 23rd at the Pheasant Run Resort in St. Charles, Illinois, the huge Mega Center Exhibition Hall was filled with four-hundred tables of decoys and sporting collectibles. Buyers and sellers come from throughout North America and beyond, both for the show itself and for the several days of room-to-room trading that precede the show. Also not to be missed: the Guyette & Deeter Decoy Auction held in conjunction with the show. It's quite probably the largest decoy auction in North America, grossing several million dollars and with individual decoys regularly selling for \$100,000 or more.

It's something you won't see anywhere else on the planet. Each year, I'm still amazed as I walk through the doors of the Pheasant Run Resort Mega Center, long-time host of the National Vintage Decoy & Sporting Collectibles Show. The huge hall is a sea of literally tens of thousands of antique and vintage decoys and other sporting collectibles, completely filling the 38,000 square foot space. For many of the dealers, it's by far their most important event of the year. But the show itself is only part of the story for the decoy fanatics.

An entire wing of the Pheasant Run Resort gets filled with collectors as early as the Monday preceding the show itself, for the all-important room-to-room trading. For some, well over half of their sales take place before the show even begins! Trading takes place all day and late into each evening, you just pop into any of the 300-plus open doors. One collector likened it to a very plush indoor flea market for decoys.

By Wednesday, there are M.D.C.A. seminars to attend, as well as the preview for the much-anticipated Guyette & Deeter auction. The auction itself is a two-day affair, held on both Thursday and Friday. Then there's the M.D.C.A. Show itself on both Friday and Saturday. Admission is only \$5 for adults and free for kids, and

there's always plenty of free parking on the resort grounds.

Each annual show has featured exhibits as well - most all from M.D.C.A. member's personal collections. This year there were three: a fascinating display of period Minnesota waterfowl decoys, a comprehensive exhibit on the history of fish-spear- ing decoys, and a surprisingly popular display of handmade Wisconsin gunning boxes - some dating back to the 19th century.

Exhibitors come from all over the U.S. And yes, you'll find the rarest-of-the-rare decoys here, selling for many tens of thousands of dollars. But those of us with thinner wallets had lots to choose from too. You'll find thousands of vintage decoys and other sporting collectibles in a more modest price range. And of the contemporary carvers' offerings, when you consider the 100-plus hours a decoy carving might take to create, their prices start to look like fabulous bargains too.

You'll find nearly everybody associated with the world of decoy collecting at this event: hundreds of enthusiastic collectors of sporting memorabilia, many noted authors, and dozens of North America's best decoy carvers. If you have a few family heirloom decoys you want to find out a little more about, feel free to bring them along. Both days of the show offer free identification and evaluation services. 







# The History of the W. Nelson McCoy's Blue Bird Pottery

An Old "Blue Bird" Pot Shop

W. Nelson McCoy was born in 1820 in Harpers Ferry, Virginia, which is located in West Virginia. In January 1848, he and his wife Ester moved to Ohio's, Muskingum County, Springfield Township, in a community called Putnam. At that time, Putnam was a suburb of Zanesville, but in 1872, it became incorporated into Zanesville.

During the same year as W. Nelson and his wife arrived in Putnam, they had a son whose name was James W. Years later J.W. would go on to establish a well-known pottery, the "J.W. McCoy Pottery".

W. Nelson came to Putnam as a farmer. He acquired some land and built a house. In addition to farming, he also built a small, log building to produce stoneware during the warmer months. The pottery was a small, "Blue Bird" type shop, which was like the ones many of the farmers had at the time. It was primitive in its equipment, and the ware it produced was rough and unfinished. Although during that period, most of the home-owned, "Bluebird" shops operated under primitive conditions.

W. Nelson only produced pottery for a few years, not eight as previously believed. In January 1853, a notice was published in the "Zanesville Daily Courier" stating that a partnership that W. Nelson had with Jeremiah Elder was dissolved. The partnership was in a Putnam grocery store, named Elder & McCoy, which had been established at some uncertain prior time.

On the same date that W. Nelson ended his partnership with Elder, a second notice was published reporting that he had taken another partner, Norman Dodge, in the grocery business. Later W. Nelson bought out Elder, and the name of the grocery was changed to "McCoy & Dodge".

35Considering his job at the grocery, and the labor involved in farming, maintaining his household, supplying clay and firewood for his kiln, one would imagine that W. Nelson only had a small amount of time for actual pottery production. Surely, the volume he produced was small, and it was undoubtedly unmarked, since none that is attributable to him has been found.

Prior to 1853 a grocery store in Zanesville was owned by "James Benjamin & Co.". Sometime after 1858 W. Nelson acquired the major share in the "Benjamin & Co.", and the name of the store was then changed to "McCoy - Benjamin & Co.". Hugh McDonald was another owner besides McCoy and Benjamin.

In addition to the operation of the store itself, James Benjamin had other interests; he was a wholesale dealer in stoneware. The newspaper "Zanes Times Signal" carried an article in 1957 by Norris F. Schneider, who, quoting old sources, said that during the 1870's Benjamin was one of the three major stoneware wholesalers in the region. The other major stoneware wholesalers at the time were J.C. Gillespie, and Hudson C. Ward.

The crock shown is an example of Benjamin's wares. The inscription on it is stenciled in blue ink, and reads, "Jas. Benjamin Wholesale Stoneware Depot Zanesville, O".

W. Nelson is not known to have been associated with James Benjamin in the pottery business in Zanesville. However, he and Benjamin were associated in the pottery business located in Cincinnati. (See the article, "The History of the James Benjamin Potteries and his Connection with W. Nelson McCoy", which is contained on this Web site).

W. Nelson as a long-time, Zanesville businessman, became respected and popular. In 1881, he was elected the mayor of Zanesville, and in 1883, he was reelected. W. Nelson continued managing and working in his grocery and dry goods store until the early 1890's. He died in 1894.





*Roseville Futura, 1928. Futura is an Art Deco line that was made in 78 different shapes and is one of the most popular lines among today's collectors. A green globe, modernistic shape.*



*Roseville Azurean vase, ca. 1902. This is blue version of Roseville's Rozane line, with hand painted decoration.*



*Roseville Egypto, 1905, in the form of an ancient Roman oil lamp.*



*Roseville Creamware "Good Night" candle holder. Roseville began making decaled Creamware utility ware by 1910 and continued making it at least through the 1920's if not longer.*



*Roseville Early Utility pitchers. Introduced around 1900 and popular for decades thereafter, Roseville made dozens of different pitchers. Some Roseville collectors specialize in pitchers alone!*



*Coffeepot from the Mock Orange line, first produced in 1950, typical of Roseville's late production style.*



*Roseville Carnelian II, 1926. This line followed a line called Carnelian I and was produced in shades of red or green or a mix of red and green.*





