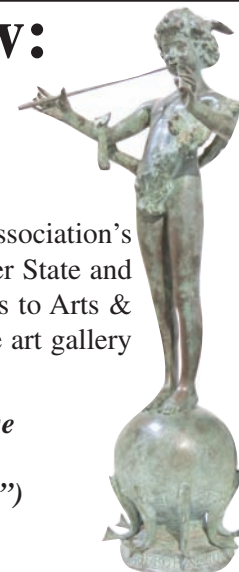

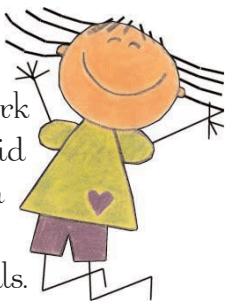

Minnesota Antique Dealers Association Celebrates Forty-Plus Years of Quality Antiques Shows

The Minnesota Antiques Dealers Association Antiques & Decorative Arts Show has been hosted by the Minnesota State Fairgrounds since its rebirth more than a decade ago. I earlier described the Fairgrounds as beautiful, and it truly is that. I first visited here several years ago, and my first impression was: what a difference from your typical fairgrounds! After passing under a large iron archway into the grounds, you're surrounded by what looks like the "streets of yesteryear," with tall trees shading the wide boulevards lined with lovely brick & stone buildings. It really is a pleasant place - and a busy one too! Be sure to stroll past the Art Deco/Art Moderne 4-H Building adjacent to the antiques show itself - and the nearby Art Deco Horticulture Building too. There are usually multiple events here on a typical summer weekend: both the International Gem & Jewelry Show and the St. Paul Summer Beer Fest shared the fairgrounds with the MADA Antiques & Decorative Arts Show on this June 4th & 5th weekend. Another nice feature of the fairgrounds: plenty of parking adjacent to the venues, and free too!

The show itself is held in the Fine Arts Building, a grand old neoclassical brick structure. The huge open room is divided by dozens of freestanding white partition walls; giving the whole space the feel of a museum or art gallery. Each dealer has plenty of ready-made wall area for hanging objects, or just as a backdrop.

Those dealers ranged from Victorian to vintage to mid-century modern, or sometimes all-of-the-above in one booth. The Twin Cities' premier consignment shop, H & B Gallery, had one of the largest exhibits at the show, bringing furnishings ranging from a classic Chesterfield-style leather sofa to a cool Charles Eames Mid-Century rosewood screen. And period fine art collectors surely weren't disappointed at what the show offered, from the paintings shown by Hiro Fine Art and Ron Christman Art & Antiques to Loretta Gosse's amazing array of fine bronze sculptures.

Things couldn't have looked more different than at Country Gallery Antiques, where Scandinavian folk art is always the focus; or in Noel Swanson's huge display of cultural artifacts from around the globe - with some examples dating back to as far as the 11th century.

Show Committee chairperson Carol Eppel told me not to forget to mention the countless hours the other committee members worked putting together this 2016 show, with the help of many dedicated volunteers. You can contact the Minnesota Antiques Dealers Association through their website www.mnantiquesdealers.com. There, you'll find a member list, an application for membership, as well as a discount coupon for admission to their annual show. And as always, keep an eye out for listings of the 2017 MADA Antiques & Decorative Arts Show in the Auction Action Antique News!

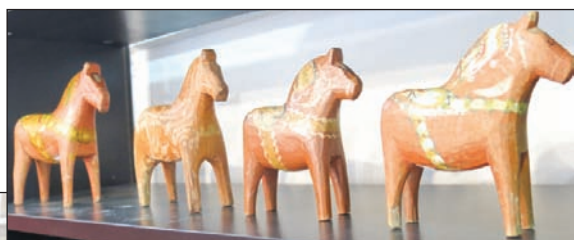

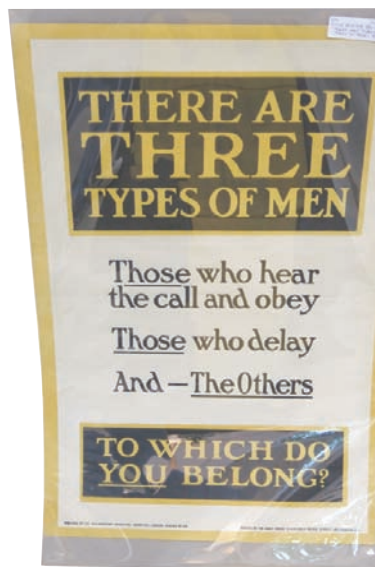

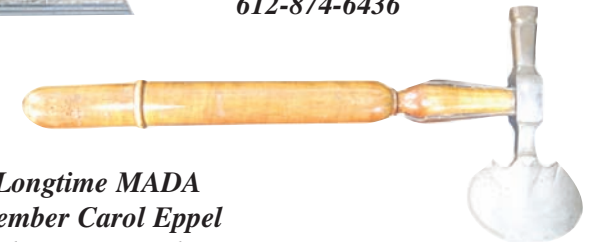

Antique Motorcycle Club of America

The Antique Motorcycle Club of America was founded in 1954 by a group of antique-bike fans in the New England area (pictured from left are T.A. Hodgdon, Emmett Moore, Henry Wing Sr., and Henry Wing Jr.). AMCA Founders In the decades since, the AMCA has grown to become one of the largest organizations of antique-motorcycle enthusiasts in the world, with 11,000 members in the United States and more than a dozen other countries.

Owner with three-wheeled motorcycle From the beginning, the purpose of the club has been the "preservation, restoration and operation of old-time motorcycles." Members of the AMCA own, restore, preserve, study or just admire motorcycles that fall into the antique category, meaning they are at least 35 years old. Although the Club is based in the United States, fans of motorcycles from all countries are welcome, and ownership of an antique motorcycle is not required to become a member.

Through its network of 59 affiliated Chapters in the U.S. and abroad, the AMCA provides a way for antique-bike fans to share their interest with others in their local area. Chapters typically host regular meetings, plus activities like bike shows, swap meets and antique-bike road runs.

At the national and international level, the AMCA maintains a calendar of National Meets and Road Runs that include some of the premier antique-motorcycle gatherings in the world. National Meets typically include a large vendor area, where members can sell everything from antique-bike parts to entire motorcycles that are at least 35 years old. In addition, National Meets offer a full schedule of other activities, ranging from seminars and bike shows to motorcycle field games and antique-bike racing.

Judging All National Meets also feature the AMCA's National Judging Program, in which members' motorcycles can win awards in three categories: Restored, Original Condition or Period Modified. Instead of competing against each other, bikes entered in the AMCA Judging Program are evaluated on a 100-point scale against the standard of the same motorcycle as it would have appeared when it originally left the factory.

National Road Runs provide an opportunity to use these classic machines for their intended purpose—riding on back roads in some of the most scenic parts of the country.

In addition to those events, AMCA members also get access to a number of benefits, including a high-quality magazine six times per year, online forums where they can seek advice from experts, and the AMCA Virtual Motorcycle Library, featuring downloadable copies of hundreds of old and rare sales brochures, parts lists and repair manuals. Plus, AMCA members receive discounts on admission to some of the country's premier motorcycle museums.

Mostly, though, people join the AMCA to meet up with others who share their interest in machines from the classic era of motorcycling. For some, that means the satisfaction that comes from investing thousands of hours in bringing a rusted hulk back to its original perfection. To others, it means preserving artifacts of the past so that they can be appreciated by future generations, or the simple pleasure of enjoying a two-lane road at an unhurried pace—just like motorcyclists generations ago.

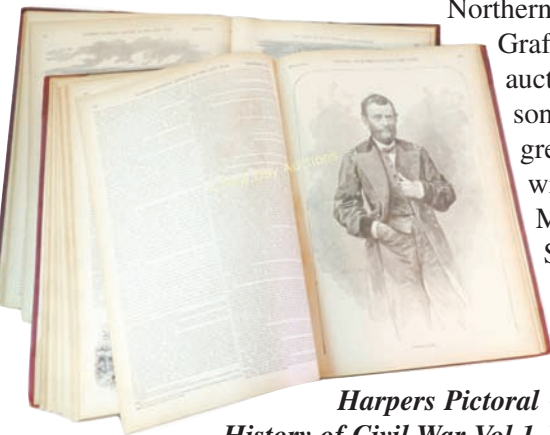

In California the warning is even placed on some buildings. Although the warning is required only on products sold in California, companies may use it on all of their products to avoid creating different packaging for sales in that state."

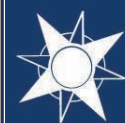

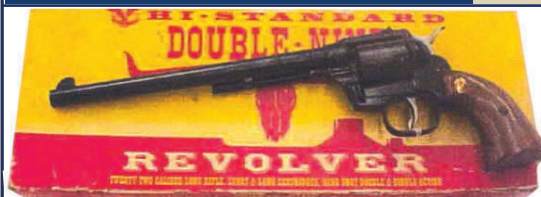

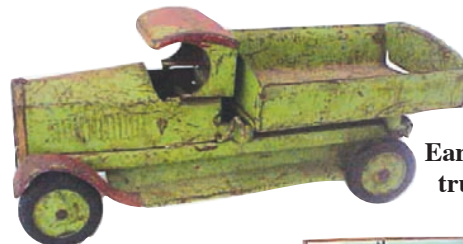
