On Saturday, March 11, 2017 at the Hilton Garden Inn in Oshkosh, WI, the Wisconsin Decoy & Sporting Collectibles Show was held. I was told this show was one I couldn't miss, so me and my honey decided to do a little road trip and make a day of it. 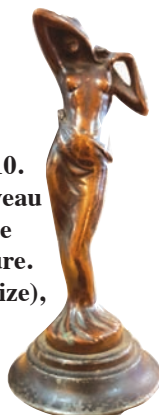

Treasures Galore at the Wisconsin Decoy & Sporting Collectibles Show in Oshkosh, Wisconsin

The show itself was Saturday, but the three days prior are set aside for trading, selling, reminiscing and admiring each others collections. Roger Ludwig, a longtime decoy collector and appraiser organizes the show. Roger told me "If you have a representable bird, reasonably priced, you are going to sell it!"

We decided to dive right in and start exploring. The very first thing as you walk in, is this stunning and very large carving by Dennis Edwards, one of a kind, \$2,000, of what I believed to be a Musky, wearing a saddle...very clever. As we walked from table to table, everyone was very friendly and informative. You will find antique and vintage decoys, lures of all kinds, paintings, bear traps, duck calls, vintage shell boxes and most anything sporting related. I was in awe of the superb craftsmanship done on these pieces at the show. Some pieces could fit in my hand they were so small. I joked with a couple of the guys and asked them if they needed a huge magnifying glass to complete their carvings. The detail on them are so beautiful and intricate.

I received a little history from Carl Halvorsen on Herman Wendt. How Herman was a mason by trade from Sheboygan, WI, and created decoys in his spare time. There were some 1940's decoys there of Herman's that were made from cork and wood. Apparently, the wood used on the bottom always ranged, depending on what he had on hand. This also applied to the eyes on the duck, some had glass eyes if he

had them, and some didn't. My thanks goes out to Carl for his enthusiastic stories, and the way he would joke around with everyone around, leaving us laughing and smiling.

We were introduced to Jim Balzer. Jim is one of the two remaining original members of the WI Decoy Show. He told us how a few guys started meeting up over 50 years ago at Horicon Marsh, they loved it so much it became a yearly tradition and eventually the show. I was admiring his Evans miniatures he carved and painted himself. Jim said he was in his mid 80's, which you wouldn't know by looking at him. Again, I had to ask how they did such intricate carving and painting...Jim recommends cataract surgery, in and out in 45 minutes and driving the next day. He took his glasses off and said, "I don't really even need these anymore, but (with a wink) my wife said I look better in them. Jim called over a gentleman he said I needed to meet, Brooks Big John. Brooks is from Lac du Flambeau, WI, also known as Lake of the Flaming Torches, which the name came from the torches when they were spearing fish. Brooks also makes decoys which he uses when spearing fish. His exhibit has traveled all over Wisconsin. You can go to Lac du Flambeau and visit the museum to see more, and you can also go to his website to watch virtual spearing @ www.arts.state.wi.us.

So, all in all it was a fantastic day and awesome show! We can't wait for next year's show!

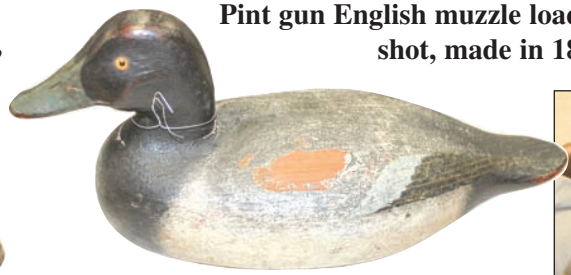
