## Let's Figure It Out!

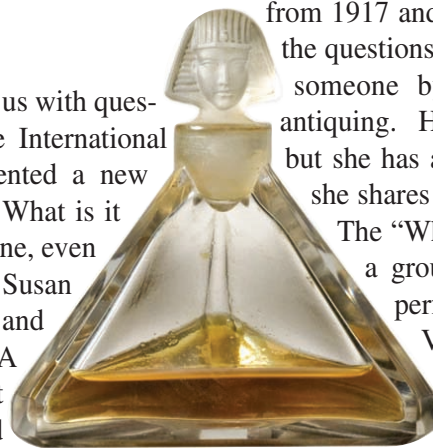

In an effort to help out the many people who contact us with questions about perfume bottles and vanity items, the International Perfume Bottle Association (IPBA) has implemented a new enhancement to their website called "What is it? What is it worth?" "This is a free service to anyone, even non-members of the IPBA", says Susan Arthur, Immediate Past President and current Webmaster for the IPBA website. "Over the years the most common inquiries we've received are people wanting to know what they have and what is its value. One of our goals as an association is to not only encourage collecting but to help educate the public, and this new website feature is bringing us one step closer to this goal. The IPBA website already has a Virtual Museum. It has a huge variety of perfume bottles and vanity items at your finger tips.

You can research all day long on it without even leaving your chair." Since IPBA's membership includes many experts in the field of perfume bottles and vanity items, Susan states "it was a natural step to use our resources to address questions regarding inherited collections of perfume bottles and the need to sell, or times when individuals have found something they aren't sure what it is."

The "What is it?" feature on the website takes you to an incredible Perfume Bottle Historian, Helen Farnsworth, if you have questions about what you have or if you want to know a little history. Helen says, "I have answered questions about archeological dig discoveries of perfume, a plane crash discovery of perfume, a bottle found in the wall of a ghost town out west and one found off the coast of a

Caribbean island near the brothels there, and a bottle found down a well that was used to date the site, (by that the well couldn't be earlier than the bottle)." Most recently Helen has helped a "gentleman who had found a bottle as a child in a 'farmers dump' to quote him. It turned out to be a Baccarat bottle

from 1917 and was quite rare and valuable." Most of the questions she answers are about something left to someone by a family member or found while antiquing. Helen does not give values on anything, but she has an incredible amount of knowledge and she shares it freely.

The "What is it worth?" feature will take you to a group of appraisers, each with a different perfume bottle and vanity specialty such as Victorian or Commercial, if you would like to have your items appraised. "The cost for appraisals at this point is between the appraiser and the person wanting the appraisal. What the site offers is the connection to the most qualified and certified group of appraisers for perfume bottles and vanity items you will be able to find just about anywhere," Susan states.

Also on the "What is it worth?" feature is a group of dealers who specialize in selling perfume bottles and vanity items if you are looking to sell. This gives you a great opportunity if you are interested in selling as the dealers are always looking for new stock for their businesses.

"It's sort of one-stop shopping" says Susan, "whether you want to know about the bottle your great grandfather brought home from WWII after stopping in Paris or you would like to know what your best options are to sell off a group of perfume bottles or vanity items. At least you can start the process here and learn more about what you have."

"What is it? What is it worth? is so easy to use. It is on our home page in the lower left hand corner in green. Just click on it and it brings you to a list of three choices - Perfume Bottle Historian, Appraisers and Dealers. Click on the one you want and send an email. Pictures do help out the process," Susan states.

"Not everything we see has a large monetary value, but sometimes the value isn't in dollars but in the story or history of the bottle that is special to the family. Helen, and I or anyone else that gets contacted through this process gets to learn things too and interact with collectors and non-collectors alike!"

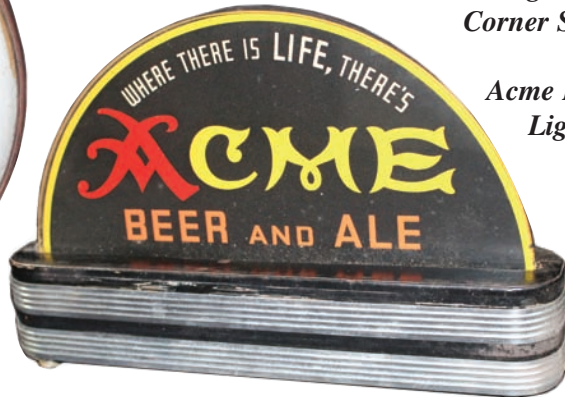

## National Milk Glass Collectors Society

### *The History of the National Milk Glass Collectors Society*

In 1984, when a group of milk glass collectors answered an advertisement placed in several trade magazines by Walter Sill, a milk glass collector and entrepreneur from Nashville, Tennessee, history was made.

Regis and Mary Ferson of Pittsburgh, PA had already published a book, Yesterday's Milk Glass Today, in 1981. This sparked the interest of Walt Sill. In 1983, Walt conceived the idea of holding a convention where milk glass collectors could come together and talk and learn about opaque glassware. Walt contacted the Ferson's, who encouraged him in his pursuits, and agreed to come to this newly conceived convention.

Walt, not being sure if anyone else would be willing to travel to Nashville, pushed ahead. He placed ads and sat back and waited for responses. Just a few months after placing the ads, he had reservations from people representing ten states and a total of fifty people with paid reservations and expectations of seventy to one hundred attendees.

The agenda at this first convention is basically the same agenda that is still followed at today's conventions. There was a dealer setup area, exhibit of rare pieces, a trading area, a business meeting and an auction of three hundred pieces of milk glass. Enthusiasm ran high and there was a general agreement that the group should meet again the following year.

Conventions were held in 1985 in Pittsburgh, PA and again in 1986 back in Nashville. In 1987, the convention was held again in Nashville and at this convention the NATIONAL MILK GLASS COLLECTORS SOCIETY was officially organized. The following were elected to office: Jim Slater, President; George Storey, Vice President; Judy Reynolds, Secretary; Kathy Mroz, Treasurer. The first executive board members were: Helen Storey, Terry Baker (Simpson), Margaret Horsman, Stan Sohl, and James Reynolds serving as its Chairman. Mary Ferson, Regis Ferson, and Walter Sill were voted as Honorary Presidents (later modified to Honorary Members).

The NATIONAL MILK GLASS COLLECTORS SOCIETY is dedicated to the preservation, study, and enjoyment of milk glass including all periods and manufacturers, both domestic and foreign. The society promotes research projects, informa-

tion exchange, and social activities to increase and enhance the knowledge and acquisition of milk glass by its members.

Our official publication, Opaque News, is issued four times a year, in March, June, September, and December. Each issue, averaging between 15-20 pages, contains notices about the society's activities, articles on the history, production, identification, and other concerns relating to milk glass. Listings and color photos of previously unlisted pieces are featured, as well as reports on auction sales, book reviews, and members' activities. Members are also welcome to place ads, free of charge, listing pieces they wish to sell or buy.

Above all, the society seeks to promote communication and good fellowship among its members in the United States and International.

Each year, the society sponsors a convention. The convention is held in various parts of the United States to allow members from different areas to attend. We seem to hit the eastern and middle states more as volunteers are always needed to host, and they seem to be coming from those states. We have been to Texas, Kansas, Ohio, Indiana, Tennessee and Pennsylvania just to name a few. The program includes prominent speakers, an auction of three hundred pieces of milk glass, and arrangements for dealers and individual members to sell, buy, and exchange pieces. Check our Convention page for the upcoming convention and to check out our previous conventions.

Membership entitles you to Opaque News, the society's newspaper, admission to the convention, and all the talk about milk glass you can stand. We have a library from which all members can check out resources by notifying the librarian.

Two of our members have published a book, called, The Milk Glass Book, by Frank Chiarenza and Jim Slater. The members of the society provided the items to be photographed for the book. It is currently available through the Schiffer Publishing Company and other book sale outlets.

The Society has access to original molds and produces a different commemorative covered animal dish each year. The Society owns several plungers that are used to stamp the Society logo and the date and place of the convention for the year the commemorative is pressed. These are then sold at the convention and can be purchased by members only.

**A:** In a divorce assignment, there are 5 choices. 1) date of separation, 2) date of filing, 3) date of trial, 4) date of decree, 5) the courts discretion. The correct choice depends on the state

you reside. Minnesota uses the date of trial to value marital property. It is a prospective appraisal.
