# TOY STORY" - The Marshall Version



The extraordinary toy collection of Alan and Connie Marshall is hard to put into words. Looking at over 40 years of collecting

is hard to imagine. You can spend hours just looking at them, oh but for a real treat - wind them up. There are airplanes that fly, Jalopy's that drive,

dancers that dance, boxers that

box, pool players, ping pong players, walkers, dogs that chase cats, cats that chase dogs, hundreds of them, the next more fun than the last.

The Marshall's incredible collection spans from the early 1900's to the 1960's with a main emphasis being pre 1940. The collection boasts over 400 pieces and includes a broad range of interests including several Popeyes, The Lil Abner band, The Merry Makers Band, Howdy Doody, Amos and Andy, Robots, Rockets, Lehmann's Balky Mule, and the Toonerville Trolley. There are also historical Black Americana Toys like Jazzbo Jim, Dapper Dan and Poor Pete, many circus and carnival toys, and some larger scale toys like race

> tracks, roller coasters, flying planes, Ferris wheels and more, so

Pick up a Toy reference book with vintage windup toys and take a look at some of their featured toys, you'll find many in this collection.

Alan and Connie were married for 51 years. They met, married, and lived in

Whitewater Wisconsin. During the first 10 years of marriage, the children were young and money was tight so they didn't collect. But once it began, it was a passion they both would share. They soon loved to learn about the toys, their makers, and their references to the history behind them. They presented displays for the Whitewater historical society events and loved to share their knowledge of toy collecting with oth-

Just listening to Connie talk about the collection and the experiences they had collecting is a pleasure. You can sense how special it was for the two of

them to share together. Connie thought that part of Alan's passion for toys came from his early years. His family didn't have much money and he didn't have many toys, he simply shared a used bike and a wagon

with his brother. As an adult he developed an interest

in them, enjoying the variety and fun of each.

Alan's first toy was an Amos and Andy Fresh Air Taxi that he purchased with his youngest daughter at the Monroe Auction in Wisconsin, all the way home his daughter kept asking "how are we going to tell mom how much we spent" - Alan's approach was that they "just wouldn't tell her", but she never asked and it didn't matter - so began a passion that would continue for the next 40 years.

When people would look at their vast collection, Alan would often be asked what his favorite toy was - his response would be that "He loved them all". He loved to get them out for the grandchildren and wind them up.

Alan passed away suddenly this past year, which is why the collection is being offered at auction.

Connie had trouble listing a favorite toy, but when pressed mentioned the super German made Ferris Wheel, with special meaning as it is the last toy that Alan and her purchased together. They both loved the color and the

detail of the people.

Alan and Connie never sold any toys, they simply collected. They attended toy shows, antique shows, flea markets, and auctions, primarily in the Midwest and in the last 10 years were regulars at online toy auctions. They

purchased from / Bertoia, and a host of auction houses. mentioned a

favorite shows like Smokehouse

Square in Amana, Iowa, the Boys and Girls Club show in Appleton, All The WADA (Wisconsin Antique Dealers Association) shows, St. Charles, and Ann Arbor Michigan,

abut they would go anywhere that their toy hunting adventure took them.

Connie smiled when she told us that while their friends went on cruises, they

went to toy shows and bought toys. At the shows Connie would walk ahead and scout the tables to find the toys of interest and Alan would do the purchasing. He didn't

barter much believing that both buyer and seller should feel good after the sale. And he usually knew right away if he wanted it.

One of the funniest stories that Connie shared with us was of an Indian toy that Alan purchased. It was called Crazy Indian and in Connie's opinion wasn't very attractive or appropriate. She asked Alan "why did you purchase

that thing", but Alan liked it because of its his-

thought "it was awful". All of the toys in their collection were nicely displayed in display cases - However Connie made sure that The Crazy Indian spent most of its time in a drawer.

This was probably the most fun we've ever had setting up an online auction. When we put the catalog together, the toys went from a photo station to a test and video station and ultimately to cataloging. Winding them up and seeing them move was so interesting - It seems like Todd must of said "oh this is my favorite" 50 or 60 times! At which

time, everyone would gather and watch the toy in action.

Once they had been photographed, videos taken, and cataloged, we would place them neatly on our storage racks. It was funny how you would walk by some-

times and someone would be buzzing, or moving - we actually stretch wrapped all the shelves so no one went for a walk or drove off the edge. We often wondered if when we weren't there it was like Toy Story and they were all playing.

As with most great collections, it is fascinating to hear the stories and history behind the collection. This was no

exception, listening to Connie talk about collecting was wonderful and made this special group of toys even more special.






























# The American Society of Military Insignia Collectors

Whether an individual is an experienced or beginning collector shoulder sleeve and distinctive unit insignia (patches and DIs), rank insignia, wings, decorations and awards (medals), elite forces emblems, cap badges, specialty markings, or of simply information on heraldry and the symbolism of heraldic devices, membership in ASMIC has many advantages.

ASMIC publishes a quarterly journal entitled The Trading Post and a Newsletter. The Trading Post contains a wealth of information on all aspects of U. S. and foreign military insignia. It includes articles from members, illustrations of old and new emblems as well as an occasional color section depicting American or foreign insignia. Unidentified Insignia are covered in a separate column in The Trading Post






