

## Reginaphone Table Model Hexaphone Phonograph Brings \$22,000 at Donley's Vintage Music Auction

Prices were strong throughout the auction. Some of the items bringing the most attention were a Reginaphone table model Hexaphone phonograph that brought \$22,000, an Edison Class M electric cylinder phonograph that sold for \$12,000 and a Victor Eldridge Johnson Type B trademark phonograph that played it's way to \$7,500.

One of the most interesting pieces in this sale was a Lenzkirch Grandfather clock with a 15.5" music box. The piece stands just under 9' tall at 105", an Englis penny must be inserted into the right side of the cabinet to listen to the music box. The disc plays twice for one coin. This stunning piece did not sell, but if you are interested, you can contact the office.

Another nice piece was a restored Capitol phonograph lamp that brought \$3,000. Manufactured by Burns Pollak of Chicago, this great looking piece has been totally refurbished, replated and the electric motor has been gone over, including new elec-

tric cord & new lamp shade. The new lamp shade has been remanufactured on a different style frame than was originally used by Capitol Lamp.

Randy Donley is co-owner of Donley Auctions and is the liaison between consignors and buyers. He has 40+ years of experience as a collector and dealer of antique phonographs and music boxes. He is also the co-owner of the Wild West Town, a family owned attraction with one of the best phonograph collections in the nation (certified by the Thomas Edison Institute). Randy is a charter member of Early Talking Machine of America. He is the founder of the world's largest antique phonograph event held annually since 1975 in Union, Illinois (Antique Phonograph & Music Box Show).







## **Antiques & Appraising School Releases Data On Top Selling Items**



The latest results from the Asheford Institute Of Antiques survey of buying trends within the antiques and collectibles community were recently published online this past week by the school's Research & Polling Department.

After conducting similar surveys over the past five years, the internationally recognized home-study school on antiques, collectibles and appraising, released its latest trending data from the antiques marketplace for the 2016 year. The survey, which concentrated on compiling and grouping information related to customers buying habits over a twelve month period, was brought back this year after a strong response on the school's website from readers requesting updates from previous surveys, said current Director of the Institute, Charles Green. He went on to note that there were some interesting differences between the results from this poll, and

those from previous years. "We've made our questionnaire sharper, and more specific, as well as bringing the participant base up to over 1,200 respondents, but the questions are still essentially the same," said Green, "even though the answers are quite different."

Carlee Jackson, the school's public relations director agreed with Mr. Green's assessment, and stated that the main goal of this year's survey was to once again measure the interest in current trends of antiques and collectibles, based on actual sales results and requests for specific items.

She noted that while the survey was informal in nature, and not predicated on scientific formulas, the results were still quite compelling when viewed in their entirety. "What we're seeing is a strong change in direction when it comes to certain areas of the decorative arts..." said Jackson, "It's not just Mid-century modern that's moving, but a number of other areas that are also making up ground." Jackson went on to note that interest in 1960's and 70's collectibles, particularly space and Star Wars related items, had also risen sharply as well. "There's no doubt in my mind that these are the new younger collectors that we're seeing today," said Carlee. "They're the one's who are really beginning to drive the industry forward."

Aside from the popularity of Mid-century modern furniture, many of the younger dealers from the survey also noted that literally anything twentieth-century, from brutalist metal sculptures to lesser known painters had also become increasingly sought after by both dealers and collectors. "We're in a virtual bidding war every time something from this era comes up," said Shannon Smith, a young east coast dealer. "Honestly, sometimes I wonder if it's worth all the fuss!"

Older dealers seemed to echo a similar sentiment, but indicated that there were other areas of the market that were beginning to show signs of renewed interest, particularly in the area of Greek and Egyptian revival styles - especially when done in stone and marble. Claude Paquin, a longtime dealer from Quebec, said some of his Victorian marble-top side tables, which hadn't moved in years, were suddenly flying out the door. "Who knows," said Paquin, "...maybe it's the beginning of something old!"

## \$ Wanted! Reward! \$

We own the large portrait photo of Wyatt Earp (taken by pioneer woman photographer Candace Reed in Quincy, Illinois in 1870) which is seen below on the top left. This photo was likely stored in the dark for almost 150 years along with the now missing matching portrait of Wyatt's first wife Urilla Sutherland. We believe both were sold out of the excess inventory of the Manitowoc, Wisconsin County Historical Society sometime in the 1900s. We will pay at least \$25,000 (this amount is negotiable) to own the missing portrait of Urilla which is likely hanging in someone's house in Wisconsin or a nearby state. However, we must be able to examine it in order to determine it is her. If you have a portrait which measures 36" by 22" (frame O.D. 41.25" by 27.50"), and the frame matches the one Wyatt is framed in, and it's a woman wearing 1870s clothes- chances are you have the portrait we are looking for. We do not know what Urilla's dress looks like. Urilla may look like her

sister Velma (seen below on the right) but she could be wearing a different style dress or jacket than the one shown in the frame below on the left. The best clue is the 36" by 22" actual size of the photograph which may also exhibit a strong resemblance to her sister Velma or the woman in the photo below in the center. Unlike Wyatt, the frame she is in may not be damaged. Like Wyatt, her portrait could also be signed Burger & Reed. An ad was run offering her for sale (as Wyatt's wife) around 2003-2006 in one of the antique newspapers distributed in WI. We will pay \$5000 to the first person who can provide us with an original copy of that ad which shows Urilla's portrait.
