Mauser Banner Luger 9mm Pistol Brings \$2,950 at Cady Auction Gallery

As in the first auction, the combination of a full house, phone bidders, absentee bidders and online bidders equaled about 700 active buyers. The interest in militaria and firearms have stayed consistent amongst collectors, and especially World War II militaria and collectible firearms. Each of the three collections were put together by respected collectors in their field.

The stars of this auction were a group of WWII German Lugers, all in good condition. There were heated battles amongst bidders for the Luger pistols with the top seller being a Banner Luger pistol selling for \$2950 (all prices are before the buyer"s premium). Close behind the Banner was a Mauser 42 Luger selling for \$2300, a Mauser S/42 Luger ended on \$1900 and a BYF P08 Luger selling for \$1800. Walther pistols were also hot items with a Model PPK Police pistol selling for \$975, a Model PP 32 cal brought \$760 and a 1936 Olympia 22 target pistol elling for \$1500

Other German WWII items that soared to great prices were daggers; Kriegsmarine dagger sold for \$750, 1936 dagger with scabbard & hanger sold for \$1900 and a SS dagger with scabbard and hanger sold for \$1000. The bidding on a P08 holster and magazine topped at \$400. Medals, or badges, are always popular. It seems the Germans had a badge for every accomlishment. A Gold Wound Badge sold for \$150, War Order of the German Cross badge sold for \$350 and a SS Long Service Award badge sold for \$950.

Cady Auction was honored to have been chosen to sell these fine collections. Splitting them up in 3 different auctions, holding down the number of lots, helped to hold the prices up garenteeing good results for their consignors. 




