## Fantastic Three Day Labor Day Weekend Auction at Tumbleson Auction Center

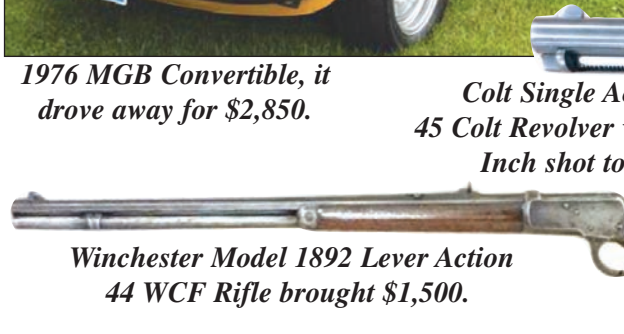

## Simmons & Co. Auctioneers Sells Fantastic Bob Heavner Collection in September

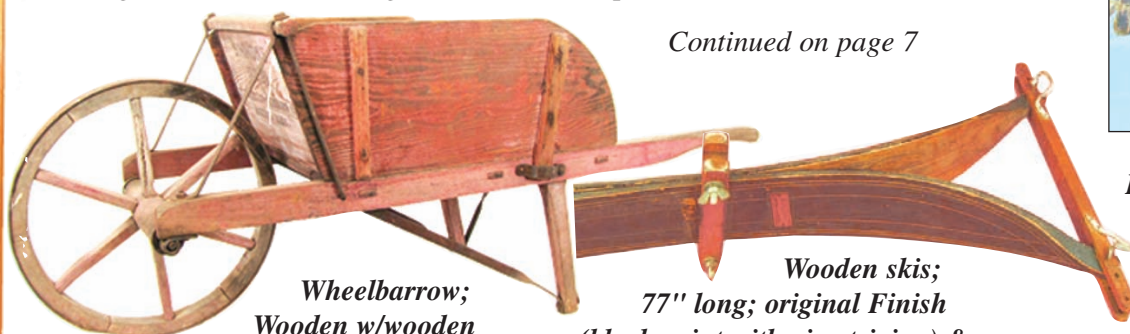

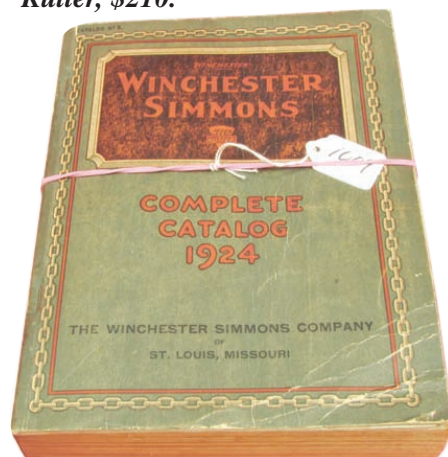

All the major cowboys had their own TV shows and the merchandising machines took advantage of that exposure.

Comics, toys, games, cap guns, clothing, lighting, bicycles, yo-yo's, just about everything imaginable was sold that could be connected to a cowboy.

# What's Fascinating About Collecting Is That Virtually Anything Is Collectable Nothing Should Surprise You, But It Will!

I'm betting most of the readers of Auction Action Antique News were never at a loss for something to do in their youth. I, for one, had boxes and bags of collectables in my closet. My grandmother, with me in tow, would walk plowed fields in the spring looking for sundry items that, for lack of any description, were just neat in my eyes. Rocks, pottery shards, arrowheads, bottle tops, china, and occasional round things filled my pockets for the transport home. A few hours of scouring yielded a few dozen artifacts. After a soak and scrub, they were amazing to look at, hold, and sense the history. I was hooked and have been walking plowed fields ever since. Only after my grandmother passed away did I learn that she had planted a few seeds in those fields. Little did I know she led me to those treasures stepping over the seeds so I would know the excitement of a find. She showered me with praise for having good eyes to spot an arrowhead or pottery shard on a clump. She knew that it was important that the time I spent scouring those fields had a more important meaning than a walk in the dirt. I've been walking in dirt for decades. Never bored, the hours go by in anticipation of the next 'find'.

Today, or any day in 2017, might be a good moment to mention that as much as you, who are most likely collectors of something, would be hard pressed to find a youngster in your neighborhood willing to lay down his phone to walk in dirt for a few hours. I was an educator for 33 years and at the beginning of the year I would have my students fill out a form so that I might know a little about them. I asked nothing personal, but I did ask if they had a hobby or collected anything. Some did, but those that did usually followed a parent passion. Our schools keep them so busy with academics and athletics, and that along with their 'screen time', leaves most of them with little extra time for pursuing a hobby.

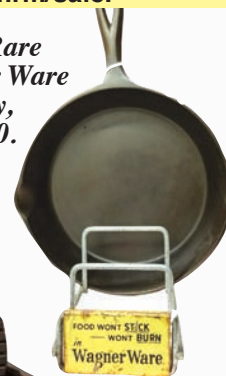
