



### Fantastic Time at the 3rd Annual Octagon House **Antiques & Art Show**

Artist Nancy Bicknell is Celebrating 50 years of displaying her artwork. Creating works of art combining her pen, inks, etching and acrylics into original collages. Merging 50 years of art work into new images with texture, giving a dimensional appearance as though one is looking back in time. This series of country scenes, set in the City of Watertown, WI will bring back memories for many and stir the hearts of the young.

Stoughton Antique Mall came to the event to share demonstrations of Mourning & Funeral Customs, Homefront items from WWI & WWII as well as some of there Mystery Monday Items that can be enjoyed at there location each week.

Brandon and Bryana of Becker Antiques have a display of great furniture everywhere they go! So much to see and so many things that you will want to take home.

The construction of the Octagon House includes central heating, running water and ventilating systems. In addition to those "modern conveniences," the house features a central spiral staircase which rises from the first floor to the tower room.

Occupied only by Richards' family members, the house was given to the Watertown historical Society and has been open to the public since 1938.

On the grounds you will see "The Plank Road Barn" that was built in 1853 and used by regional farmers driving cattle to the Milwaukee-Watertown Plank Road. It was moved from the Plank Road area east of the Rock River to this site in 1863 and restored by the Watertown Historical Society to feature great pieces of history. As well as the "First Kindergarten" this is the first kindergarten in the United States was founded by Margarethe Meyer Schurz in this building in 1856. Moved to the present site and restored in 1956 by the Watertown Historical Society.

This property also has a gift shop on the grounds as well as a great display of museum pieces on the upper floors of the Octagon house. The floors that have original furniture from the Richards family is something to see! The guided tour is educational and intriguing, this is a must visit site!







#### The Tea Leaf Journey from England to Mid-America



In mid-September, Tea Leaf Club International members travelled to St. Louis, Missouri, for their 38th annual convention. It was fitting that the convention's educational theme centered on the travels of Tea Leaf ironstone from the kilns of England to the homes of early settlers in America's heartland.

Every year members look forward to the gathering as an opportunity to socialize, renew friendships, and share their experiences in searching

for and purchasing the beloved Tea Leaf, including variants and other copper lustre decorated ironstone. Convention activities include welcoming new members, informal discussions around the dinner table, an informative tour of the host city's historical sites, table sales of Tea Leaf related items, educational presentations, and the much-anticipated auction.

Following a delightful game about Tea Leaf body styles, answers were presented through a demonstration of matching the makers and body styles using the Online Identification Guide. The Guide, accessed through the Tea Leaf website, is an excellent source of information about the potters and their history, body styles, motifs, and descriptions of the various pieces. At this time, the Guide contains over 1800 photos. More are added regularly by the Education Committee, as information becomes available. Use of the Tea Leaf Online Identification Guide is free and available to the public.

The presentation of Tea Leaf travels was incorporated in a skit with characters sharing their involvement in the journey. It emphasized the many aspects of Tea Leaf Ironstone from manufacturing to shipping to retail to collecting. The majority of Tea Leaf travelled over 4,200 miles, over 100 years ago. Just having beautiful pieces to admire now is nothing short of amazing!

At auction time, 180 lots were offered. Bidding was robust, with some items selling for bargain amounts and some very pricey, depending on the collectors' interests and wallets. The highest bid was garnered by a rare Teaberry motif mug at \$700. Among the other high bid items were an unusual Teaberry brush vase, a Teaberry ewer and basin, a Wedgwood Fleur-De-Lis Chain Tea Leaf brush vase, a Burgess Tea Leaf brush vase with under-plate, and a Meakin brocade Tea Leaf three-piece soup tureen. More than 50 lots sold for more than \$100.

With the 2017 Convention completed, members now look forward to September 2018, when they will convene again to celebrate Tea Leaf Ironstone. Meanwhile, the search for interesting and usual pieces of the durable ironstone continues.

The Tea Leaf Club is dedicated to the study and collection of Tea Leaf Ironstone China and its Variants, produced in England and America from the mid-19th century through the early 1900s. The club boasts hundreds of members from almost every state in the union who collect, study, love, and appreciate the simple beauty and endurance of Tea Leaf Ironstone China. The club welcomes new members and enthusiastically shares their appreciation for the sturdy, attractive pottery. #### The Passing on of Native American History

The Prehistoric history of the Native American Indian is reflected in their hand made weapons and tools. The oldest Artifacts, such as arrowheads, date back 14,000 years and span across the Paleo-Indian Era (Stone Age culture) and the Clovis and Folsom cultures.



A massive private collection that was started by one family member in the late 1800's was passed on through the family for all these years. This Keil family Collection from Iowa home will be passed on to the public and hopefully start the next generation of family collections. It is very important that the prehistoric history of our oldest American family members be preserved and

passed on through our museums and collectors. Very seldom does a massive and diverse collection of this Magnitude come on the market. They are usually passed on to museums and other private collectors that keep them stored away, never to be seen by public eye.

The family spent several thousand hours carefully and artistically sewing and gluing the many artifacts on to boards for display in their basement. These artistic displays will rival any museum. This magnificent displays can be seen at www.mwauctions.com/ .

The collection contains approximately 9,000 items. Most of the collection was found in Iowa but many others in Illinois and Wisconsin. A family diary was kept

of where many of the artifacts were found and when. These artifacts were numbered as shown in the auction catalogue. A copy of this information is in family diary that will be copied and made available to buyers.


This diverse collection covers the Paleo period of 9000 BC to 14000 BC including artifacts of Clovis, Cumberland, Fulsom, and Dalton arrow Heads and spears



### 2018 American Art Pottery Association to Convene in Ames, Iowa

The upcoming annual convention, Show & Sale of American Art Pottery Association will be held at the Gateway Hotel and Convention Center in Ames, Iowa. The event will be held April 25 - 28, 2018 and will feature a tour of Iowa State University campus art collection.

In the depths of the depression Grant Wood and the colony of artists from Stone City spent time beautifying the campus with murals and sculpture. What's left is an enduring grouping of master pieces situated throughout the campus along with more contemporary works. On display for attendees at a lunch gathering will be the pottery produced at the college by Professor Paul Cox and Mary Yancey in the 1920's.




