## Rainbow Traders Holding Fantastic Auctions Since 1974

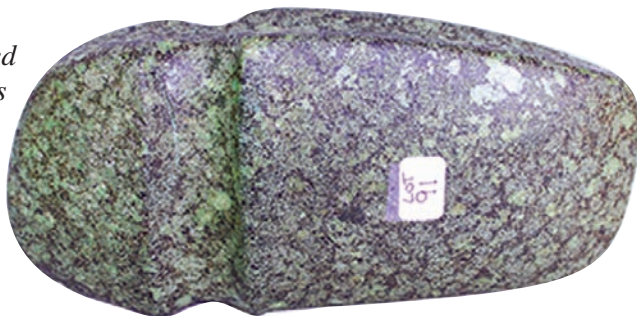

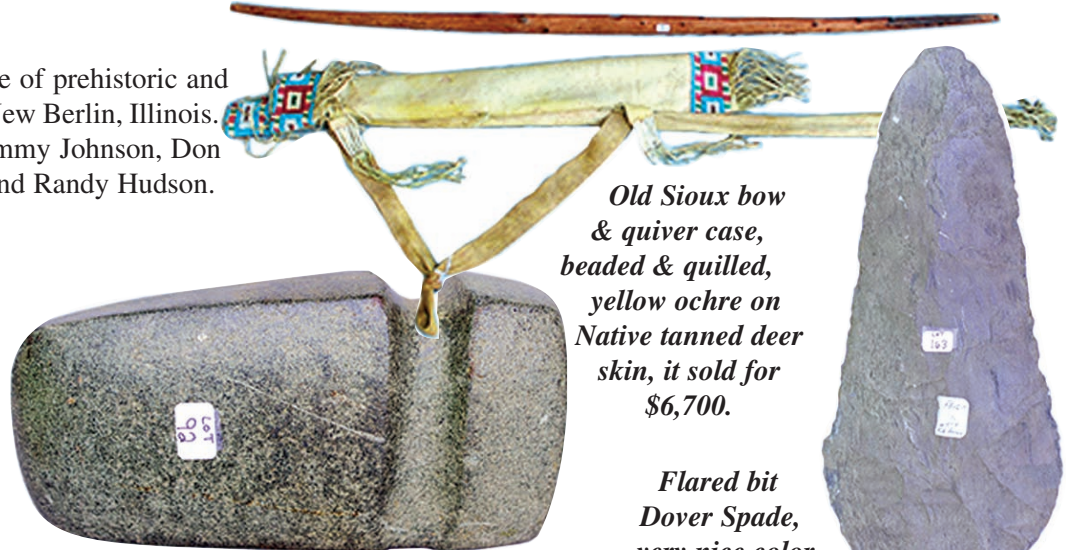

Growing up in Bibb Co., Alabama, Charlie West can't remember a time in which he did not hunt Indian relics. Born in June 1936, he served in the Army Signal Corps as a US Army Captain in Alabama in the early 1960's. Charlie taught Educational Psychology in Tennessee and 32 years at the University of Illinois. In his professional career he published 4 books and over 60 articles. He wrote several articles and has had relics pictured in *Central States Archaeological Journal* and *Prehistoric American*. As an avid field hunter, he discovered over 30 sites in Tennessee, Alabama and Illinois.

The late David William Wood grew up in Clay Co., Illinois. He hunted relics from the time he was a child and throughout his life in Illinois, Georgia and South Carolina.

Thomas "Tommy" Johnson grew up in the small town of Lafayette, Louisiana, where he was constantly searching the fields for relics with his brother, Paxton, from an early age.
