




VanDerBrink Auctions Sells Fantastic Clyde Brown Estate



The Miracle of the Mericle Collection -

Hundreds of collectors from across the country have participated in these events. The level of excitement and participation from local collectors has been outstanding as the collection has a heavy emphasis on Wisconsin pottery and bottles.

Don was a special person – as a collector he was known and respected by so many. He served his country in the US Army, was proud of being a Mason, and was a tender hearted loving person who cared for nature and animals. He was known for his incredible love for history and antiques, and the preservation of them. The Mericle property has wonderful historic buildings and antique pieces. Several of those buildings Don painstakingly moved and reassembled on location. When sold in upcoming auctions, the contents of the property will be a fantastic museum quality walk back in time.

It has been so interesting as the stoneware and bottle collection was brought to the market, to listen to many of his friends that would take time to tell stories of how they knew Don and how much they respected his knowledge. Stories of a special find, special dig, or some adventure they were on.

This next auction coming in November will include the remainder of the stoneware and majority of the bottles in the collection. Some might think that after this many events, the "good stuff" would be gone. While some incredible items have been sold so far, there are items coming that will interest all. The most significant of these is the highly sought after Blossoms Badger Ale Milwaukee bottle. early 1960's. Several articles have been written about this bottle.

Tina (Don's Wife) had scheduled a time for us to stop and pick up the Blossoms Badger Ale and a few of the bottles that were still left on location. This few turned out to be over 60 from a special cabinet off of their kitchen. As auctioneers, sometimes you open doors and go Wow - this was a Wow moment!
