

### PER LYSNE (1880-1947)

Per Lysne (1880-1947) of Stoughton, Wisconsin is celebrated for reviving rosemaling (the Nor-wegian decorative art form) among second and third generation immigrants during the early 20th century. He also decorated and sold smorgasbord platters, tines, and trunks and provided decora-tive work on kitchen cabinets and home interiors. WADA member Phil Schauer will bring some exceptional samples of Per Lysne's work for the special exhibit and he will also have examples for sale in his booth.

### EXPECT THE UNUSUAL!


