## Good Crowds - Great Buys, at N.L. Promotions **2013 West Bend Antiques Show**

As I'd noted a few weeks ago, it was very encouraging to see the large crowd at the January 5th & 6th Janesville Antiques Show. That trend continued at this West Bend Show, with folks lined up bright & early for the show's opening – and good attendance on both days. And the mild weather we've had for most of the winter made travel for us antiques enthusiasts a pleasant task.

The Pavilion Building at the Washington County Fair Park was host for the show, as it has been for the past several years. It's become a popular venue for events of all kinds in this part of the state, and it's not hard to see why. The state of the art facility, about thirty minutes north of Milwaukee, offers easy highway access and unlimited free parking. The soaring windows let the natural light flood in. It's a great place to spend the day on a Wisconsin winter weekend.

Toy collectors found much to like at the show. Yesterday's Memories came with a huge assortment, from antique cast iron toy stoves to a Buck Rogers Ray Gun complete with box. More toy gems could be had at the nearby Pearmont Antiques, who brought not one, but two, hard-to-find WWII-era Buddy L toy cars made of wood due to metal rationing during the war.

There were several furniture dealers of note at the show too, including Ken's Family Antiques. They don't show often, but when they do, you know they'll bring some exceptional pieces from their Fond du Lac shop. My favorite there this time was a little different though – a circa-1960 Belmont barber chair in chrome, white enamel, and faux leather, asking price \$895. There was plenty more restored 19th century fur-

niture at L & L Antiques and Second Chance Antiques; and Portobello Road Antiques brought their usual great selection of Arts & Crafts furniture and accessories.

Sporting collectibles more your thing? There were finds scattered throughout the exhibition hall. That included some choice vintage eastern seaboard decoys at Sommerville's Antiques. Among them: a folky New Jersey brant carved by Bill Brown, asking price \$495. And in the eclectic assortment at Lotz of Stuff sat perhaps the oddest sporting artifact at the show: a vintage Air Boy motor & propeller attachment that clamps onto your fishing boat to transform it into an airboat of sorts, and only \$350 to boot!

As you probably know, N.L. Promotions are the folks who also run the massive Elkhorn Antique Flea Market. When they started the event back in 1982, a good show meant a few dozen dealers might show up. Fast forward three decades, and Elkhorn has grown into one of the biggest and best indoor-outdoor antiques markets in the Midwest - with 500, 600, or even 700-plus dealers at each of the four summer

This year's first Elkhorn Market will be here before you know it, on May 19th. Don't forget to mark your calendar with the rest of the 2013 Elkhorn dates too: June 30th, August 11th, and September 29th. N.L. Promotions can be reached at 414-525-0820. 




Randy Rengel was a successful farm & commodities trader, who hunted relics as








