Hundreds of Bidders Vie for Hundreds of Classic Signs at Miller's Auction Company February 16th Sale

Tomah, Wisconsin was the place, and February 16th the date, of a great Miller's Auction Company sale featuring hundreds of choice petroleum, agricultural, and brewery signs. Bidders came from several states for a chance to bid on the 300-plus lots, all sold to the highest bidder at the Monroe County Fairgrounds Hall. Strong prices were the rule at the standing-room-only sale, with highlights including a rare Chevrolet Super Service sign that made \$4,000, and a 6' John Deere Farm Implements sign that fetched \$3,450.

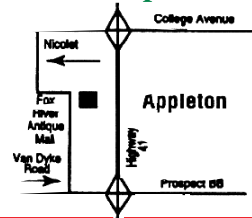

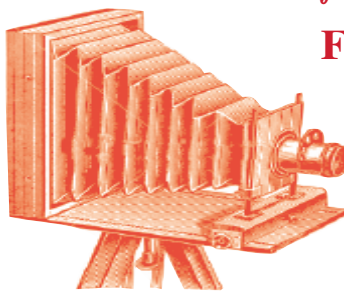

Gas and Farm Advertising the Focus at Huge Miller's Auction Company Sale in Tomah, Wisconsin

It was quite a sight as I arrived at the Monroe County Fairgrounds on the brisk Saturday morning of the sale. Hundreds of classic signs filling row after row of tables, plus many more jumbo examples lining the walls of the building. This February Miller's Auction Company sale has become an annual event, with owner Glenn Miller scouring the countryside for an entire year to find the best in quality period advertising. And as expected, a large crowd filled the hall to overflowing by the 9am start of the event.

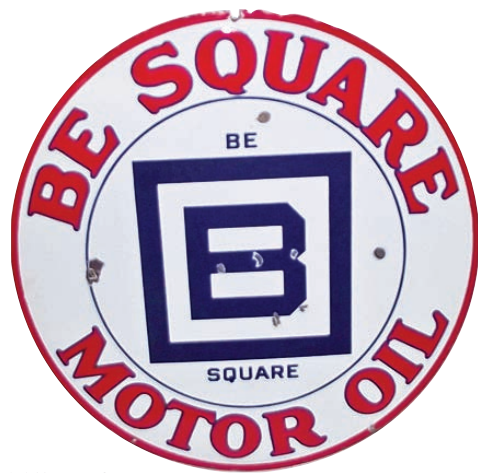
The petroliana collectors were here in force, and for good reason. There were some hard-to-find automotive-related signs here, many in exceptional condition. That certainly described the rare 49" diameter Chevrolet Super Service round porcelain sign that was the top-lot of the sale at \$4,000 - and the equally-rare and early Francisco Auto Heater self-framed litho-tin sign that fetched \$2,800. A classic 48" embossed porcelain Shell sign was also in great shape, and sold for a solid \$2,500.

And while automotive advertising dominated the sale, there was plenty here for breweriana and soda collectors too. Best by far: a super-rare Leinenkugel's Chippewa Pride Beer reverse-painted sign that made a cool \$3,700. A 60", two-sided Drink Coca-Cola sign was the day's soda advertising winner, selling for \$950.

A small-but-nice group of agricultural signs did just as well. Leading the way: a 6'-long John Deere Farm Implements "three-legged" porcelain sign that brought \$3,450. A mint-in-box 48" Shropshire Sheep porcelain sign was another ag-advertising highlight, trotting off for \$1,300.

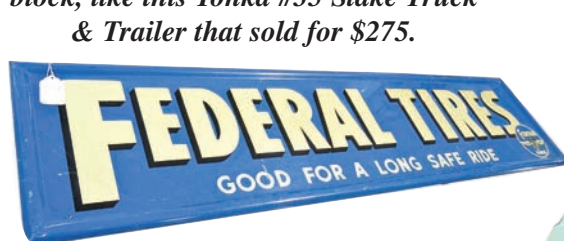

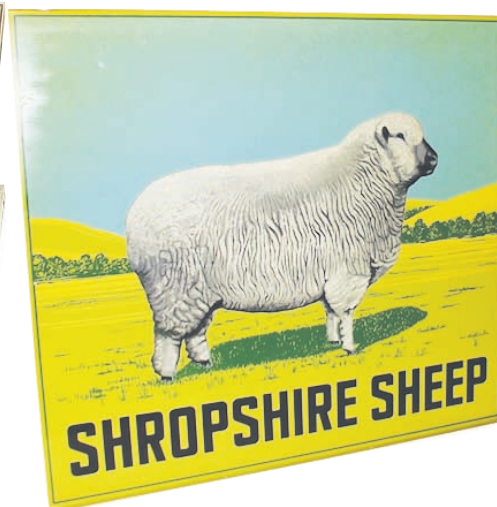

Oshkosh Expo Center Hosts 11th Annual Antique Sporting & Collectible Show

It's hard to believe, but I've been coming to this show for nine years now. And there's always been a good-sized crowd waiting in line at the show's opening, even if the weather hasn't always cooperated. This year, fair skies greeted visitors for both days of the event. "The hardcore collectors will always come out, bad weather or not," show organizer Dennis Gauger told me, "but when the weather cooperates, the more casual collectors will come too. We always get good attendance for the event, but this year we had among the best turnouts ever." I guess there's no doubt that sporting collectibles are still one of the hottest segments of the show scene.

The Sunnyview Expo Center is just off of Interstate-41 on the north end of Oshkosh. It's a quick and easy drive from Milwaukee, Chicago, or just about anywhere. The modern facility has abundant natural lighting, 24-hour security, and drive-thru loading and unloading for the dealers who require it. And there's plenty of free parking just outside the front door. Admission to the show is only five-bucks, and Sunday is Ladies Day, with free admission for the fairer sex. Kids under sixteen get in free. Local oldies radio station WVBO broadcast live from the event, adding to the already festive atmosphere.

There were quite a few professional antiques dealers among the 125+ folks showing here, but most are hobbyists looking to buy, sell, and just have a good time. Collector Don Ludy was one of those hobbyists. He set up here with a wide range of everything from baseball collectibles to a small-but-choice group of vintage fishing lures. My favorite among them: a rare Li'l Abner "Schmoo" Plug Bait complete with its original box, asking price \$300.

Native American artifact collector John Welsch brought his usual amazing array of items. Most impressive was his display of Native American beadwork pieces, but he also had a wide range of basketry and pottery representative of tribes from through-

out North America and beyond. Notable examples there ranged from a century-old Western Apache star basket (\$1,150), to a huge Tlingit red cedar halibut fishhook sporting an effigy bear face, asking price \$750.

Not into the great outdoors? There's still plenty here for you too. Rich Rohan's booth was crammed with hundreds of vintage advertising pieces and much more. And toy collectors found much to love at the show, especially at J & B Collectibles, where the inventory ranged from an early Buddy L pressed steel Baggage Truck (\$1,595) to a battery-operated Fleet Line Sea Comber toy boat, complete with box and priced at \$320.

Whether you're looking for a \$2 fishing lure, a \$200 Inuit carving, or a \$2,000 antique decoy, it's a good bet you'll find it here. Even if you're not a sporting collector, the Oshkosh Antique Sporting & Collectible Show is still one of the most interesting shows you could attend.

Promoter Dennis Gauger has worked hard over the past decade-plus to grow and improve the show; efforts that have not gone unnoticed by the exhibitors. In fact, at last year's 10th Annual Show, Dennis received a hand-made keepsake box signed by those very exhibitors filled with everyone's favorite gift – money! And Dennis promised me that next year's show will be better still, with a brand-new Captain Denny's Sunday Seminar exploring the fishing and touring opportunities on Alaska's beautiful Kenai Peninsula.

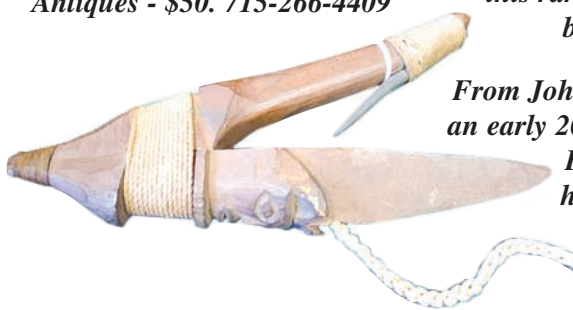

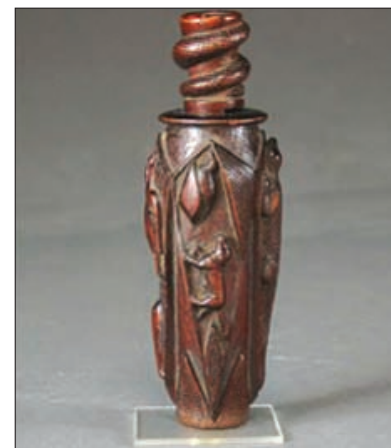

I can easily see Marty, Cameron or another carver doing this type of item for their residences, shops or hunt spaces. I have been in several hunt clubs that could sponsor such work. 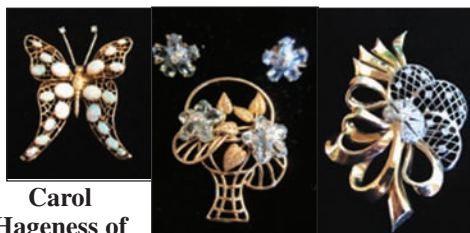

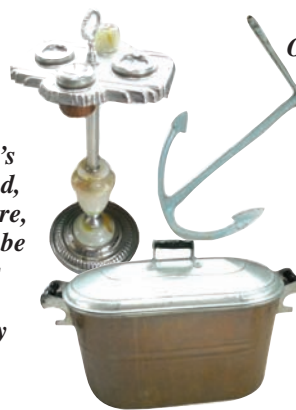
