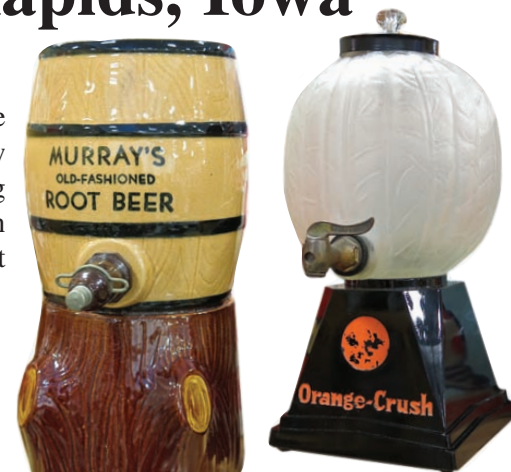

A Century of Wisconsin History Crosses the Block at October 19th Folkers Estate Auction

Antiques dealers often tell me "you just don't find those great old estate auctions anymore." Well, they were proven wrong at a recent Dale Folkers Auction Service event, where items from a southern Wisconsin estate with a history dating back many generations were sold to the highest bidder. It was a perfect autumn Saturday for an auction, held just east of Lake Geneva. The 19th century neoclassical home was a fitting backdrop for the sale, with all its contents arranged on the lawn. Highlights included a nice group of double-wheel coffee mills - the best bringing up to \$1,000 each.

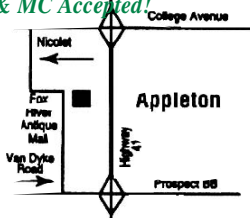

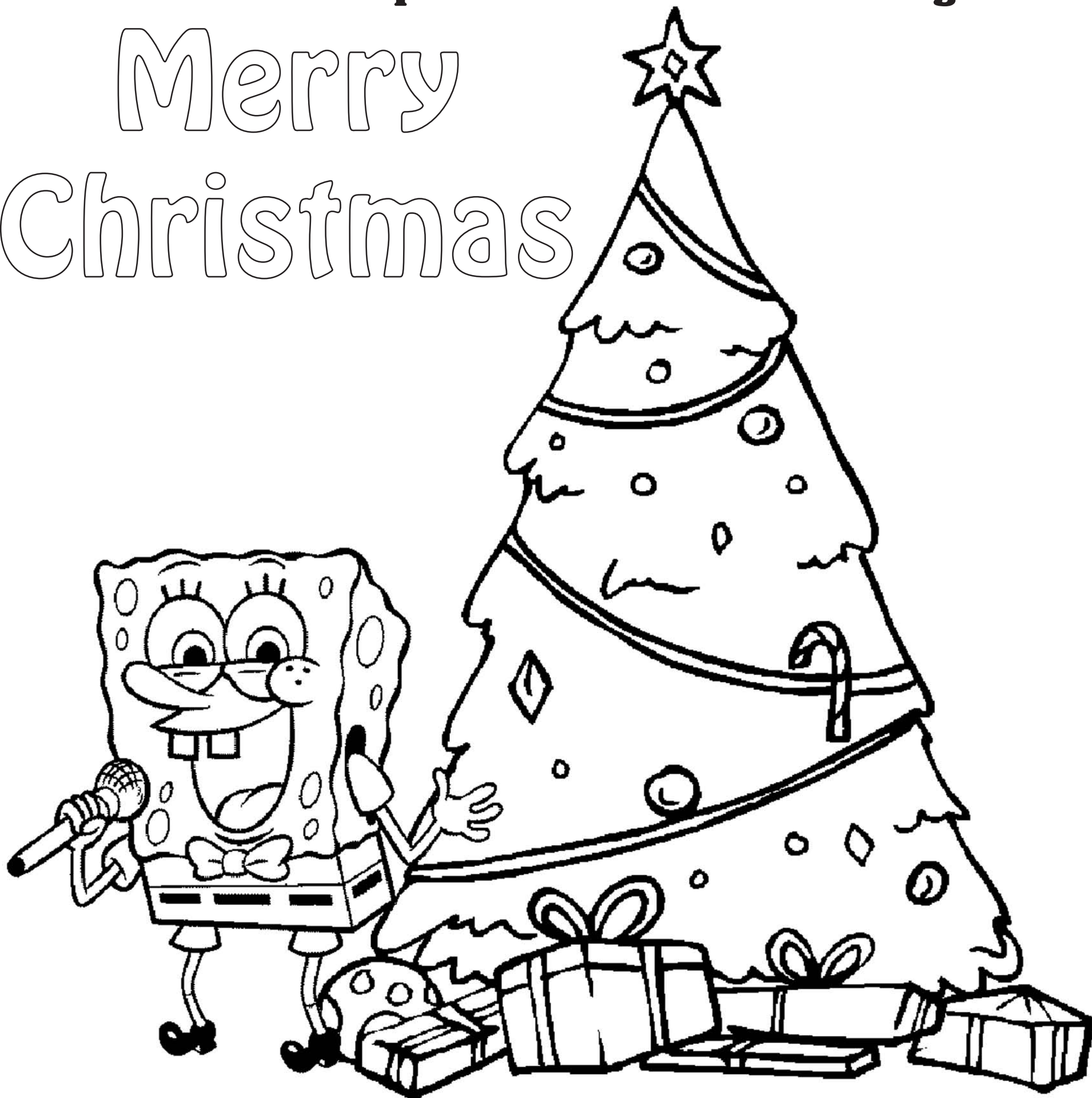

Hawkeye Downs Expo Center Hosts 54th Midwest Antique and Art & Collector's Eye Shows

At first glance, Cedar Rapids, Iowa might not seem like the logical location for such a large and successful antiques show. If you take a second look though, it makes a lot of sense. The growing Cedar Rapids/Iowa City corridor is now home to nearly half a million citizens. For generations, the city has been a center of agricultural manufacturing, with huge factories such as General Mills and Quaker Oats providing jobs to many. In fact, Cedar Rapids still processes more corn than any other city on the planet.

And now Cedar Rapids, part of Iowa's Technology Corridor, is home to a large and growing number of high-tech industries. It may not be as far away as you think either: you can hop in your car and be here in less than four hours from Chicago, Omaha, or Minneapolis.

The Midwest Antiques and Decorative Arts Show has been part of Cedar Rapids antiques scene for more than a generation, and the Hawkeye Downs Exposition Center has been its home since the very first year. An expansion of the Exposition Center in 2005 allowed the show to expand right along with it.

The show's promoters decided to use the space to create a sister show, The Collector's Eye Antiques, Collectibles, & Art Show, to bring in dealers with a different feel. While the Midwest Antique & Art Show has always been known for art & Americana, The Collector's Eye Show has a broader focus, with dealers specializing in everything from graniteware to vintage advertising to fashion jewelry.

Midwest Antique Promotions founded the event, and still runs the show to this day. Consisting of three area antique-selling couples who were having trouble finding a quality antiques venue, the group decided to just start their own antiques show right here in Cedar Rapids. All three pairs, Cathy & Thomas Rawson, Colleen & Louis Picek, and Paula & Tom Van Deest are still active dealers, setting up at each Midwest

Antique & Art/Collector's Eye Antiques Show.

They bring a wealth of experience in all aspects of the antiques business, as collectors, dealers, and antiques shop owners. Noted dealer & collector Colleen Boland Frese has a big job herself, managing the forty dealer-strong Collector's Eye half of the show.

There, you'll find dealers like Indiana's Orwig Antiques, whose amazing display featured a life-size Marilyn Monroe boardwalk display figure; Illinois' advertising & toy purveyor Anne's Antee; and Iowa's own Country Carousel, who came with hundreds of country store artifacts.

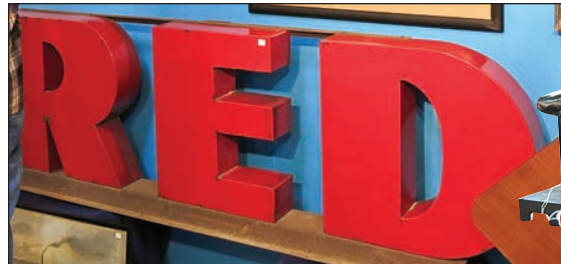
Back in the Midwest Antique & Art side of the show, dealers like R. L. Myers Americana & Folk Art came with that and more - my favorite there a classic country step-back cupboard in old red paint. More unique Americana awaited at the eclectic Over Hill Over Dale, where the inventory ranged from country stoneware to antique kitchenalia to oddities of all sorts. In fact, the more than sixty exhibitors on this side of the show offered most anything you could name, from Mid Century Modern furniture to industrial design to modern art and more.

It's a one-day show, so you better keep moving if you want to see all of what the hundred-plus dealers have to offer. I hope the photos will give you an idea of what the show's like. 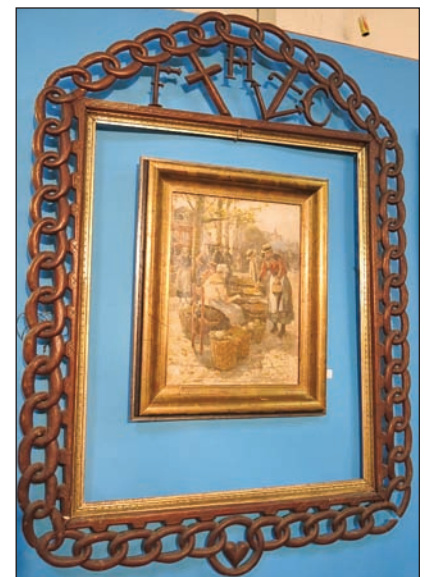

Folkers Auction Service Sells One-Of-A-Kind Wisconsin Estate

The 1850s home had been in the family for generations, situated near Lake Ivanhoe outside the resort town of Lake Geneva, Wisconsin. In fact, family members told me that the home once served as an inn of sorts, taking in visitors and shuttling them back and forth to the nearby lakes. That was long ago, and when the ninety-two year-old family matriarch residing in the two-story frame home passed away recently, her descendants gave Folkers Auction Service a call.

A sea of antiques were spread out in both the front and back yards of the rural property. Countless chests, dressers, and tables of all descriptions. At least eight 19th and early 20th century bedframes of wood, iron, and brass. And of course that antique coffee mill collection, which more than one member of the Association of Coffee Mill Enthusiasts came to bid on. A repainted Star #15 double-wheel model was the winner of the bunch at \$1,000. I liked a smaller Enterprise #8 mill in good original paint, which did well too, selling for \$800.

Furniture was strong from start to finish. Of the several dining tables, a round oak example with claw & ball feet did the best at \$325, with a square oak table just behind at \$300.
