





Autumn Edition of the Lake Country Antiques & Art Show Impresses Them Again

The Lake Country Antiques & Art Show. The name may still seem new to you, but the show certainly isn't - it's just the new moniker for the venerable Delafield Antiques Show. With the move last season to improved facilities at the Olympia Resort & Spa in nearby Oconomowoc, show promoters Ron & Debby Christman decided to change the name of the quarter-century-old event to better reflect the show's position as the premiere antiques event in the region just west of Milwaukee known as the Lake Country.

And the venue has a lot to offer for both visitor and exhibitor alike. There's a generous amount of free parking, plus nearly 20,000 square feet of exhibition space in two adjacent ballrooms. The resort also boasts 190 oversized guest rooms and suites, gourmet dining, an in-house night club - plus the 17,000 square-foot Olympic Spa.

But of course, I was here for an antiques show, and the exhibitor's displays were as impressive as ever. Fine art is a specialty here at the Lake Country Show, and shoppers found great examples all over the hall - from regional paintings at Michigan's E. Patrick Gallery to 19th century English pastoral landscapes in the display of London dealer Randall Hopkins Art & Antiques.

Period furnishings more your thing? Terry & Angela Brinton's display was a good place to start looking. There, shoppers found some distinctive Wisconsin country furniture, my favorite an imposing 19th century "jailhouse" cupboard. Or the many treasures at Harold Cole Antiques, who came from Connecticut with his usual excellent array of traditional New England furniture and more. And those of us with more casual tastes found much to love at Michigan's Christibys, whose booth was overflowing with lodge furnishings of every sort.

And with seventy dealers coming from as far afield as Connecticut, Rhode Island, and London, there's something here for every taste and budget - from early American lighting at Colleen Frese Antiques to a monstrous thirteen-foot-long, thirty-eight star American flag at Henry Teloh Antiques.

It's finds like these that keep shoppers coming back to the Lake Country Antiques & Art Show year after year. Ron and Debby Christman of the Antique Center at Wales did their usual great job organizing the event. Their multi-dealer shop, The Antique Center at Wales, is worth a look too, housed in a beautifully restored 19th century barn in nearby Wales, Wisconsin,





manatees, but Save the Manatee Club's adoption program created this passion and enthusiasm in them that's very wonderful for me as an adult to be part of. I can't tell you how thrilled my nieces are to get the newsletter addressed personally to them. They read every word front to back. Who knows, the Club may have just created the next generation of marine life specialists dedicated to the conservation of these wonderful creatures."

Save the Manatee Club, a national nonprofit organization, was co-founded thirty years ago by singer/songwriter Jimmy Buffett. Funds from the Holiday gift adoptions help with manatee rescue, rehabilitation, and release efforts; research; education and public awareness projects; conservation work to protect manatees and their habitat; and for programs in the United States, Central and South America, the Wider Caribbean, and West Africa. 






