





Wisconsin's 1854 Octagon House Museum hosts Antiques Show to Benefit Watertown Historical Society

Well, it'd be hard to describe a more perfect day: a sunny Saturday morning at one of Wisconsin's best-known historical sites, surrounded by dozens of the Badger State's finest antiques dealers. That's where I spent Saturday, September 12th - date of the First Annual Octagon House Antique Show & Sale in historic Watertown, Wisconsin. Held to benefit the Watertown Historical Society, the show was held right on the grounds of the iconic 1854 brick home.

The home was built by early Watertown settlers John and Eliza Richards, who had moved some years earlier to the area. By 1853, the town was booming along with the Richards' mill business, and the couple purchased the 105-acre parcel above the river with the intention of building a home befitting their social status.

Richards chose the design of the structure himself: an octagonal floor plan, which had been popularized by several architects and authors of the day as a more efficient and economical alternative to the more traditional rectangular home. The three-story home measures exactly fifty-feet across, and boasts more than fifty rooms.

And although it was one of the largest pre-Civil War homes to have been built in Wisconsin, it's not a traditional mansion. Meant as a working house, it was built largely of local brick and lumber. The millwork came from trees cut right on the property, milled of course at the Richards' lumber mill in town. The family resided on the first two floors, while employees of the mill were housed in several rooms on the top level. And surprisingly, Mrs. Richards employed no permanent staff: she and her daughters prepared meals for the workers who dined right along with the family

But of course, we were here for an antiques show. Around three-dozen dealers exhibited at this inaugural edition of the event, some under two tents, some on the

lawn proper. The Rock Step Antiques was among them, bringing classic Americana the Richards would have felt at home with. And furniture was the focus at Beneath the Dust and Village Blacksmith Antiques, where shoppers found a wide array of both restored and original-paint country furnishings.

Looking for something a bit more funky? There was lots to choose from all over the show. Cynthia Weston's Divine Treasures came with a great mix of colorful vintage finds, from folk art furniture to a matched pair of humorous life-sized husband & wife lawn ornaments. And right next door at Country Cupboard Antiques sat some wonderful children's toys, including an adorable kid-sized Daton wheelbarrow and an early Overland coaster wagon sporting steel-rimmed wooden wheels. A look at the photos will give you an idea of all the treasures you missed!

Of course, the Octagon House is always worth a trip in itself. It was considered state-of-the art in 1854, complete with central heating and running water. After residing in the home for eighty years, the last of Richards grandchildren passed away in the 1930s, and the family donated the property to the fledgling Watertown Historical Society. They've been good stewards to the home, most recently completing an exhaustive restoration to the exterior in 2006. The home today looks much like it would have in its heyday, complete with many of its original furnishings.

The Octagon House is open daily for guided tours from May through October, with special Christmas tours on the last week in November. Also on the property: America's first Kindergarten building, founded by Watertown educator Margarethe Meyer Schurz in 1856.
