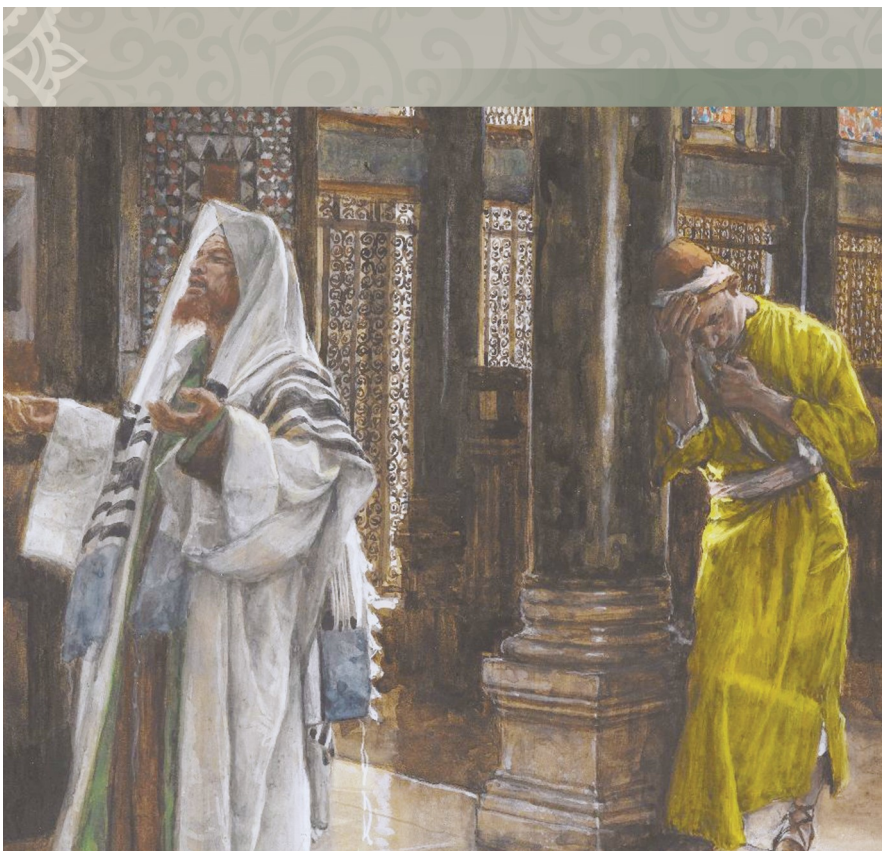

Priesthood Sunday

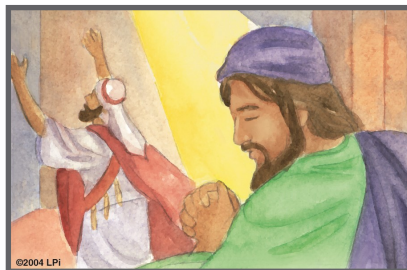
Dear Father George,

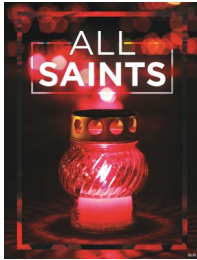
