From the Desk of Father George

Greetings Parishioners and Friends of St. Julie's,

On this First Sunday of Lent, we are confronted with our sinfulness and the habits that separate us from God and one and other. After being baptized, Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil. As the Son of God, He was not immune to temptation... but as the Son of God, He was also able to confront and respond to the temptation in a fashion that gives us hope and direction.

The season of Lent calls us to leave our addictions and pacifiers, our comfort food and toys behind and journey to the desert, to be alone with nothing but God. It is a time to take a hard look at the *addictions* that control us and regain control of our time and values so that we may become the man or woman God created us to be. May our *desert time* alone with God over the next 40 days, help us refill our souls and spirits with the wisdom and grace of the God who constantly seeks us out and calls us back to him.

Finding time to attend the various opportunities of Lent can be avenues of God's grace calling to us. Consider celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation, attending a weekday Mass, or participating in The Stations of the Cross. Lent is much more than a weekly Fish Fry.

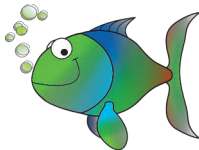
