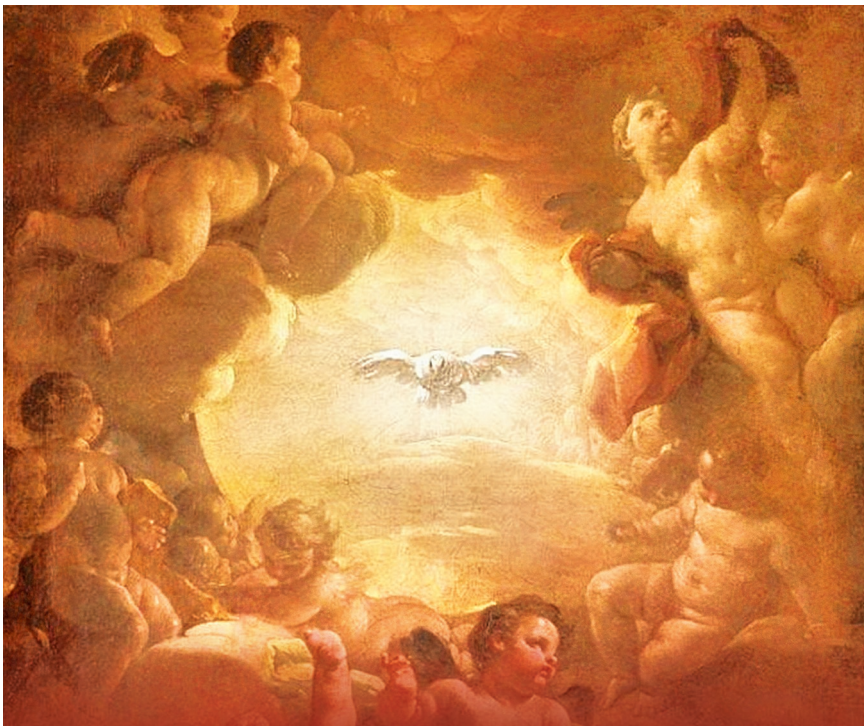


## PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

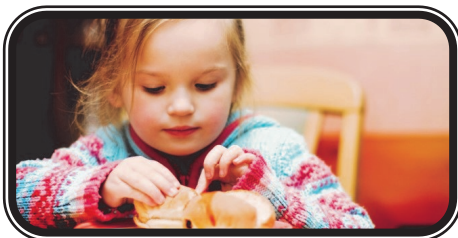
