## From the Desk of Father George

Greetings Parishioners and friends of St. Julie's,

As we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension, we are reminded of the following truths of our Catholic Faith:

- Jesus' earthly ministry is at an end and the disciples are assured that they are not to be alone. They become witnesses of the kingdom that will have no end.
- Jesus' and the Holy Spirit's mission is accomplished in us.
- The disciples were commissioned to continue Jesus' work of forming the kingdom with the support of the Spirit. They are to proclaim repentance and the forgiveness of sins that are part of our sacramental treasury.

The disciples' experience of the ascension of Jesus must have been indescribable. They are told to stop gazing heavenward and focus on spreading the good news. Sometimes we want to spend our time looking to a God who is "up there" in heaven, and we lose the message of Jesus - that He is to be with us here and now. We are to be witnesses of that message in our homes and workplaces in all we say and do. How well are any of us doing? Do we talk, think and live in His love as He has commanded?

Jesus continues to be with us. Next Sunday is Pentecost - the great birth of the Church and of the Holy Spirit descending upon the Apostles. Our liturgical celebrations remind us of not only events of history, but the all-encompassing offerings of our faith.

As the weather turns warmer, many persons have asked me to remind everyone about dressing respectfully for mass. Try to use good judgment by showing reverence for God's house, the Eucharist we celebrate and the family of God that we form as the worshipping assembly. Thank you for understanding.

**On this Memorial Day Weekend** we reverence the work of those who have served our nation and gone before us. While they are gone from our sight, their example of service continues to inspire generations to do the same. As their graves are decorated this weekend with the symbol of our nation, take some time to remember them with more than a picnic or free day. Teach your children and grandchildren about Memorial Day and pass on to them a new or renewed sense of patriotism.

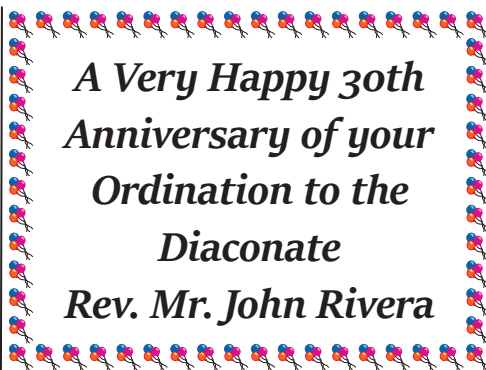
