

From the Desk of Father George

Greetings Parishioners and Friends of St. Julie's,

In today's Gospel account Jesus walks on the water toward the disciples who were a few miles offshore in a boat. Their fear that a ghost was coming toward them may have been a natural response to an unexplainable sight... and yet Jesus sought to calm them as best he could. Central to the scene is Peter's quickly failing trust in being able to do what Jesus commanded.

Fear is a normal human response to the unknown, but where and in whom do we place our trust? Acknowledging Jesus' love for us can lessen our fear or anxiety. Praying for the courage or strength to face our trial is not selfish. Placing ourselves into God's hands provides the opportunity to see and understand many things... and even if we still do not understand, can we trust that grace and blessings come in many different ways? This week, walk on water if you dare, but leave the support of yourself in the arms of the Lord!


Religious Education

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) will once again convene in late summer or early fall. This is an opportunity for those who have never been: baptized, those baptized outside the Catholic Church, or those baptized Catholic who have never received the sacrament of Holy Eucharist; to be baptized, profess their belief in the Catholic faith or to complete the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation. 


